TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

At a session of said Court, held in the City of Lansing,
County of Ingham, State of Michigan, this 27th day of

This matter having come before the court on the ex parte motion of Plaintiff,
Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD), for an

Temporary Restraining Order to require Defendant Moore Murphy Hospitality, L.L.C., D/B/A Iron Pig Smoke House to cease operating a food service establishment without a valid license in violation of MCL 289.4101(1);

This Court having reviewed the verified complaint and motion;

This Court finds that Plaintiff has demonstrated the necessity for immediate action to prevent the continued violation of the Michigan Food Law, MCL 289.1101 *et seq.*, and that continued operations of Iron Pig Smokehouse creates an imminent threat to the public health;

This Court further finds that absent this temporary restraining order, MDARD and the public will suffer irreparable harm;

NOW THEREFORE, Defendant Moore Murphy Hospitality, L.L.C., D/B/A Iron Pig Smoke House is hereby ordered to cease operating a food service establishment and cease selling, distributing, or advertising food or beverages. It is further ordered that Defendant will appear before this Court on

February 4, 2021, at 9:00 am

a.m./p.m. to show cause why this Temporary Restraining Order should not be converted to a Preliminary Injunction. This hearing will take place via Zoom (4148812799.)

This order shall be served on Defendants no later than January 28, 2021.
