DAY 1: SEPTEMBER 27, 2023 DEPART WASHINGTON DULLES

DAY 2: SEPTEMBER 28, 2023 CROSS INTERNATIONAL DATELINE AND LOSE A DAY!

DAY 3: SEPTEMBER 29, 2023 ARRIVE SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA

Group will be met by our local representative in the arrivals halls area in front of flight-designated gate for the group transfer to the hotel. Note – check in time is 2:00pm. The rest of the day is at leisure.

As Australia's largest city, Sydney embraces its harbour, taking the sea and natural waterways to its heart. Sydney, with over 4 million people is the oldest, biggest, and liveliest city in Australia.

DAY 4: SEPTEMBER 30, 2023 CITY TOUR & OPERA HOUSE & EVENING HARBOR DINNER CRUISE (B/D)

After breakfast at hotel, group will have a morning city and Bondi Beach sightseeing tour including a walking tour of the Opera House. Today experience the rich colonial history of Sydney, the impressive rant of architectural wonders, and the world famous harbor bridge. On the tour you will get to see the vast waterways that weave through the city, discover the vibrant culture of Sydney and experience some of the region's move loved attractions. Sydney is one of the world's most diverse places, and you will get a great overview on today's tour. Drive past the Art Gallery of NSW, Royal Botanic Gardens, the impressive façade of the Sydney Town Hall and Daring Harbour. Visit Mrs. Macquarie's chair, where you have a superb view across the Harbour Bridge and the Opera House. Next, we head to the iconic Bondi Beach which is filled with surfers and locals enjoying the laidback Sydney lifestyle. Enjoy a brief stop at Bondi for an ice cream or coffee (own expense) before heading back to the city via the historic and trendy district of Paddington and the bustling China Town before arriving at Circular Quay for some free time for lunch (own expense).

After lunch on own make your way to the Opera House for a private guided walking tour. The tour offers the opportunity to experience the Sydney Opera House in its daily operation. Upon arrival at the Sydney Opera House, please check in at the Cloak Room Desk located on the Lower Concourse. Your tour then departs from the Lower Concourse located downstairs outside the Sydney Opera House Shop. Visitors are guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognisable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century. Joern Utzon, the Danish architect who designed the Opera House, ascribed the inspiration for his masterpiece to the sails of yachts on the harbour. As the Opera House is first and foremost a performing arts center, some areas may be restricted for viewing due to rehearsals and performances.

This evening enjoy a special dining experience on the beautiful Sydney Harbour. The Gold Dinner Cruise will impress from the first moment until the last. Enjoy priority boarding and welcome reception on the 'Sky Deck', upper deck Gold seating, sixcourse degustation dining and live entertainment, all set to the spectacular backdrop of Sydney by night aboard flagship MV Sydney 2000.

DAY 5: OCTOBER 1, 2023 BLUE MOUNTAINS TOUR

This morning ravel through Sydney's inner Western Suburbs to Featherdale Wildlife Park one of Australia's largest private collections of Australian animals for a memorable and unique experience in a natural and well established bush setting. At the end of the visit we continue the journey following the trail of Australia's early explorers as the coach ascends into the Blue Mountains National Park. Travel through the historic townships of Blaxland, Springwood, Lawson and Wentworth Falls and view the National Trust township of Leura. The Blue Mountains are aptly named because of the blue haze caused by rays of light striking dust particles and small droplets of moisture in the atmosphere. The haze is an interesting scientific phenomenon, noticeable because of the heavy timbering of Eucalypt trees in the area. Drive along Cliff Drive to Echo Point to view the world famous "Three Sisters". Learn fascinating Aboriginal legends, including The Mountain Devils, The Banksiamen, The Bunyip and The Witch Doctor while enjoying panoramic views of the JamisonValley. A 2 course Lunch is included at local restaurant (beverages at own expense).

This afternoon you will have the opportunity to visit Scenic World renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains Adventure – from native birds to fresh air, to breathtaking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, Katoomba Falls & Jamison Valley (Rides at Scenic World are at own expense).

At the end of the visit we return to Sydney via the 2000 Sydney Olympic Site (time permitting). The evening is at leisure.
