Details on Setting Up Your Tree

The Live Christmas trees will be provided and set up by Lackawanna County. Participating * Make sure your decorations are organizations must supply decorations and lights (LED) that can withstand harsher weather (lights must be for outdoor use). Power will be supplied, though participants are welcome to bring their own extension cords. Trees must be set up by 5pm on December 4th. After you register, you will be contacted for set-up times, which will begin the weekend of the Thanksgiving Holiday.
