The workshop is focused on what the initial arriving companies can do to help ensure a smoother transition and safer dive recovery operations. During the workshop, you will discuss some of the challenges related to public safety dive operations and how to avoid common pitfalls.

- Discuss key concerns for patient privacy, packaging, and transfer of care
- Demonstrate the basic steps to assist a diver in donning equipment and personal protective equipment
