Did You Know?

Carlisle has been partnering with NFR since 2014 to recycle XPS, EPS, and Polyiso insulations, as well as TPO, EPDM, and PVC roofing membranes.

Recycling programs save re-roofing contractors money and help them win bids.

Re-roofing contractors who recycle help building owners exceed their LEED® and sustainability goals. Nationwide Foam Recycling (NFR) provided recycling services for the re-roofing project at Allen Premium Outlets in Allen, TX.

NFR provided live load pick-ups of 2.5" Polyiso foam insulation using 48' flatbed trailers. In just two weeks, NFR picked up ten (10) truckloads of insulation, which saved the roofing contractor over \$16,000 in avoided disposal costs.

Prior to bringing NFR onto the job, the roofer had a full-time person staged at the 30-yard trash dumpster cutting, fitting, and stacking the insulation to try to reduce the number of dumpster swaps needed. The project manager stated that stacking and loading insulation onto NFR trailers was simpler, more efficient, and reduced their labor costs.

When asked to critique NFR's service, the project manager said that NFR communicated well and showed up for pick-ups when scheduled. The only regret he had was not finding NFR sooner.
