#### From the Executive Director



First of all, as this issue of our bulletin goes to print, I think it's important to recognize that this is a challenging time around the world and here at home in Canada. Knowing that our readers might have concerns, I would like to reinforce the fact that our residents' health and safety, as well as those of our employees, volunteers and visitors to the

Home, are our top priority and at the heart of everything we do at IFH. Currently, COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) poses a relatively low risk to Canadians, however, emerging information suggests that people aged 65 and over and those with underlying health conditions or compromised immune systems are at an increased risk of more severe versions of the illness.

As we continue to learn more about the risks of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), we are working closely with public health agencies and the Ministry of Health and have implemented additional prevention and early detection measures. We have restricted all visitors, including family members and volunteers, from visiting our Homes for the time being; we have started a Screening Tool protocol at entrance, checking each employee's temperature and state of health and ensuring that everyone uses an alcohol-based hand sanitizer upon entering and at exit; all staff members have been educated on Novel Coronavirus symptoms and how to take enhanced precautions as guided by the Ontario Ministry of Health; residents have received several educational sessions on COVID-19, as well as proper hand washing techniques; all surfaces, handrails, and commonly touched areas are wiped twice daily with disinfectant and commonly used items are disinfected before and after each use; we have an Emergency Plan, as well as a Pandemic Preparedness Plan that includes emergency food supplies, various healthcare and personal necessities, and personal protective equipment (such as N-95 masks, gowns, gloves, etc.). As the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, we'll continue to respond to the latest developments and Ministry of Health directives, while keeping residents and their families informed. We appreciate your understanding and support in this matter.

Secondly, and on a different note, we are proud to announce that our excellent services to seniors have once again been publicly recognized when, on December 10th 2019, Ivan Franko Homes were awarded as "The Most Outstanding Seniors Care Providers in Canada in 2019" at an exclusive award presentation representing a celebration of the top performers in the Canadian Over 50s Housing sector in 2019, sponsored by the "Canadian Over 50's Housing News".



Thirdly, many visitors and community members have been asking about our plans to construct a new building on our Mississauga site. I would like to inform you that plans for the construction of a new Long-Term Care Home (to open 2023/24) are unceasingly underway. This will be the first part of our vision of a campus of care and 'aging in place' "Selo" (community) with an intergenerational centre having amenities and services for both young and old. Cost considerations will determine how quickly we add these additional components to our new Long-Term Care Home.

In preparation for construction of the new building, we have completed topographical surveys, hydro-geological testing, archaeological studies, preliminary architectural design and renderings, as well as costing, programming and land use studies. We have just submitted our application for new Long-Term Care bed licenses to the Ministry of Long-Term Care. Funding for the project will be arranged through a combination of Province of Ontario subsidies, mortgage loans, sale of our Royal York property and donations from our community.

We would like to remind our readers that Ivan Franko Homes' "Our Future Together" campaign, as well as our "Tree of Love" campaign, are still in progress. The "Tree of Love" fund was designed to provide starting capital for the planning of our new construction. As of March 1st, over \$1.8 million have been raised by our community (including over \$420,000 for the "Tree of Love"). But these amounts are still far short of the \$40+ million that we still need for construction of a new 128-bed LTC Home.

As a not-for-profit charity, the only way to extend or enhance our services and programs is with the community's generous financial support. With the everincreasing numbers of seniors in Canada, and in our Ukrainian-Canadian community in particular, there is an urgent need to expand our capability to accommodate more of our community's present and future retirees. We ask you to keep Ivan Franko Homes in mind during this Easter season or when writing out cheques. Please consider making a tax-deductible donation to Ivan Franko Homes which you can designate to our proposed 'Selo', a compelling, exciting, and indispensable community undertaking.

He is a member of the Ukrainian Association of Visual Artists of Canada. He has actively participated in numerous group exhibits in Canada and Ukraine, exhibiting both his paintings and his photography. Currently, Danylo works as a multimedia designer.

# **Ensemble 'Kalyna" – the Voice and Pride of Ivan Franko Home, Mississauga**

As mentioned in earlier issues of our Bulletin, Ivan Franko Home's musical residents have formed a women's vocal group to promote traditional Ukrainian folk songs. The "Kalyna" ensemble first performed for Ivan Franko Home's residents in June of 2018 during a presentation "Ukrainian Song - The Soul of the Nation". Currently this talented group consists of seven ladies – Iraida Cherniak, a renowned pianist and the leader of the ensemble, Antonina Hamiwka, Maria Makohin, Olga Romach, Olga Pylypiak, and Alexandra Foty-Toke. Adriana Ozymtchak, a young soprano and talented vocalist, often joins the residents during their performances. "Kalyna" has hosted at least five concerts, performing Ukrainian folk songs and causing a flurry of applause and enthusiastic responses from listeners. Tearful members of the audience often join in the singing with feelings of nostalgia for songs that bring to mind memories of their homeland.




