

"My Way Home"

In June, 2018, Ivan Franko Home, Mississauga, with a small grant from the Ministry of Citizenship and Immigration, published a book of biographies of our residents, entitled "My Way Home". Ivan Franko Home's social worker Natalia gathered the bulk of these social histories from our residents and verified them with their family members. This compilation of biographies is about their life journeys from childhood, through the horrors of





the Holodomor, through the atrocities of war and the difficult experiences of new immigrants in a strange country with its foreign language and unfamiliar customs. Fifty-eight residents supported our initiative and shared their life stories. One purpose of this book is to inform the younger generations of our community about these everyday heroes and their stories. "My Way Home" is available for purchase at IFH's office.

СЛОВО ВІД ЕКЗЕКУТИВНОГО ДИРЕКТОРА



Дорогі Читачі!

Дозвольте поділитися з Вами думками про близьку майбутність нашого суспільства. Приблизно за двадцять років від тепер в Канаді очікується, що на кожні 4 особи одна буде мати понад 65 років життя, а число тих, кому понад 85 років, буде зростати найшвидше за всі групи молодшого віку та більшість осіб

старшого віку буде проживати до пізньої старості. Але одночасно ми побачимо, що такі недуги, як остеопороз, дементія та артрит будуть зростати саме тому, що назагал будемо жити довше. Також певна частина старших пенсіонерів переживатиме щоденну боротьбу з різними хронічними недугами, понижене функціонування і соціяльну слабкість, що ставитиме їх на рівень найчастішого потребування повторної шпитальної опіки, функціональної залежності і низької якості життя.

Щоби запевнити потрібну опіку для наших старших генерацій, конечно буде прийняти деякі поважні зміни. Насамперед, необхідно буде перемінити наставлення молодших поколінь до старіння та до опіки над старшими. Процес старіння треба прийняти як нормальний період життя, а не як надзвичайний або критичний стан людини. Щойно тоді зможемо сподіватися на більш нормальний підхід та підготовку до старшого віку. І тому що Канада просто не в силі забезпечити потрібну опіку для зростаючого числа старших осіб, наступні покоління пенсіонерів мусять наперед застановлятися і готуватися до свого старшого віку.



Dear Readers, it is already widely recognized that the number of seniors across Ontario is projected to more than double over the next few decades, peaking in 2041 when over 25% of Ontarians will be 65 years of age or over. With this forecasted growth in the number of older adults, it is becoming more and more evident that Canada will not be able to satisfactorily handle such expansion. As seniors get older, the costs associated with an aging population increase. In an attempt to curb health care spending, governments have responded by embracing "aging in place" approaches. Aging in place has seniors remain in their homes as they age, instead of living in hospitals or long-term care facilities. And it is understandable that most seniors prefer to remain in their homes for as long as possible. However, this philosophy can have unintended consequences for low-income seniors, who generally have poorer health outcomes and greater support needs than seniors who have the means to pay for private care, if and when needed. Because of the challenges of aging, older adults as a group already experience increased risks and vulnerabilities. Due to the environmental and social barriers that many seniors face, aging in place can be especially difficult when seniors don't have access to the supports they need.

This is one reason why Ivan Franko Homes' Board of Directors has decided to undertake IFH's ambitious and visionary building project, entitled "Our Future Together". We propose to construct an "aging in place" community – a "selo"- village concept, with all possible supports in place, thus giving our seniors the opportunity of choices and options - to begin with Independent Living, eventually moving on to Assisted Living and, if necessary, continuing with full-time, 24-hour nursing in the proposed 192-bed Long-Term Care accommodations of the "selo". To support our residents, we will provide a state-of-the art facility with a medical clinic, a health and wellness centre (with a pool, as well as exercise and therapy rooms), a general store, a bistro, a cultural hub with a community kitchen, classrooms for heritage classes (such as embroidery, ceramics, weaving, pysanky-painting, etc.), a children's daycare, a seniors' day program, a chapel, a library, art studio and much more. This will also allow spouses with varying care needs to remain together on the same site.

However, in order to complete this unique, far-sighted project, IFH's must rely on the support and understanding of the entire Ukrainian-Canadian community. Please show that you care about the welfare of the next generations of our community's seniors by supporting the "Our Future Together" campaign in any way you can.

ЗБІРКОВІ АКЦІЇ ПАНСІОНІВ

Протягом року Пансіони ім. Івана Франка організовують різні збіркові акції та проекти для підтримки добробуту Пансіонів та на будівництво нового дому. Цього року завдяки проекту "Seat Sale" ми зібрали \$40,000, які покрили кошт нових крісел для мешканців Пансіону та для майбутнього проекту "Село".

Також ми провели дві успішні акції – Великоднє та Святочне Осіннє Бінґо. Усі виручені кошти були спрямовані на розвагові програми для наших мешканців. Щорічний День відкритих дверей і пікнік, який ми влаштовуємо у неділю на День Батька, цьогоріч допоміг нам зібрати понад \$8,000, які є спрямовані на реставрацію та ремонт Пансіонів.

Однією з найважливіших кампаній по збору коштів і далі залишається "Дерево Любови" ("Tree of Love"), завдяки якій за 5 років ми зібрали \$400,000! Усі кошти передбачені на планування та підгтовку проекту будівицтва нового дому. На даний момент ми на другому його етапі, а саме розробка архітектурних планів, збір коштів та отримання урядових дозволів на будівництво.

Пансіони ім. Івана Франка закликають українську громаду підтримати новий проект "Села" та нову ініціативу під назвою "Наше майбутнє – разом!" Ми радо вітаємо всіх волонтерів, між ними членів родин наших мешканців або аплікантів на помешкання, старших і молодших, студентів, учасників Денної програми для старших та всіх бажаючих подарувати свій вільний від роботи час або підтримати Пансіони фінансово.

Letter from Dr. Ihor Gadacz, Medical Director of IFH -Toronto



During my life and career as a primary care physician, I have been an active member of the Ukrainian community, which has been a source of strength and support for both me and my family throughout our lives. As a physician, I have had the privilege of caring for many individuals in the past, but my experience of providing care for our elders at Ivan Franko Homes has rewarded me with unparalleled gratification.

I have seen first-hand the significant number of seniors in our community who have benefitted from the services of a long-term care home and the support that Ivan Franko Homes has provided over the years.

The number of seniors is rising as our community continues to age. With the development of the proposed 'Selo' at its Winston Churchill site, Ivan Franko Homes is looking at increasing the number of individuals to whom it can provide care by creating more long-term care and assisted living beds, as well as an intergenerational cultural hub designed to accommodate and bring together both younger and older members of our community.

My family's donation of \$50,000 to the 'Selo' project affirms our personal belief in excellent care at all stages of life. Ukrainians have made tremendous sacrifices in their lives for their children, grandchildren, and the community at large, and my professional and personal approach as a physician is always centered around showing my sincere gratitude to these incredible individuals.

Our family donation was made through a donation of appreciated shares. The shares have grown, and had I sold them, I would have had to pay taxes on the capital gains. However, by transferring the shares from my investment account to the Ivan Franko Homes' investment account as a donation, I bypassed the tax-payment requirements on my capital gains.

I hope my story inspires you to take the time to look at finding your own special way to support the development of the 'Selo' project at Ivan Franko Homes.
