Food Service Worker Job Description

The Food Service Worker (FSW) assists in the preparation, service, and delivery of meals and snacks to residents of Ivan Franko LTC Home. Reporting to the Nutrition Manager and working under the direction of the Cook, the FSW supports safe food handling practices, ensures compliance with therapeutic diets and care plans, and maintains a clean, sanitary, and safe kitchen and dining environment that promotes residents' health, comfort, and well-being.

Role and Responsibilities:

- Assist the Cook with meal and snack preparation while following safe and sanitary food handling techniques.
- Set dining room tables according to standards and prepare dining areas for meal service.
- Portion and serve meals attractively based on resident choice, dietary requirements, textures, and care plans.
- Prepare trays and deliver meals to resident rooms and other designated dining areas, as required.
- Take and record food temperatures before service and monitor storage area temperatures as required.
- Wash, rinse, sanitize, and properly store dishes, utensils, pots, pans, and equipment following infection prevention and control (IPAC) standards.
- Perform cleaning duties in the kitchen and dining areas, including equipment, counters, floors, refrigerators, and freezers, in accordance with cleaning schedules.
- Assist with receiving, checking, and storing food and supplies; maintain adequate inventory levels.
- Report food, equipment, and safety concerns to the Nutrition Manager or Cook promptly.
- Follow all Health and Safety policies, WHMIS guidelines, PPE requirements, and Safety Data Sheets (SDSs).
- Support a positive dining experience by working cooperatively with interdisciplinary team members.
- Attend required training sessions, staff meetings, and in-service education.
- Always maintain confidentiality of residents' personal health information.
- Perform other duties assigned by the Nutrition Manager/Cook.

Qualifications:

- Successful completion of or enrollment in a Food Service Worker program at a recognized college; or
- Completion of or enrollment in a Cook/Institutional Cook apprenticeship program under applicable Ontario legislation; or
- Relevant institutional, healthcare, restaurant, or hospitality food service experience, in the Home's reasonable opinion, while actively pursuing related education.
- Successful completion of a Food Handler Training Program approved by Toronto Public Health.
- Knowledge of therapeutic diets, safe food handling, and infection prevention practices.
- Strong verbal communication skills and ability to work collaboratively in a team environment.
- Valid Vulnerable Sector Check
- Proof of tuberculosis (TB) vaccination.
