Chartered on December 19, 1990, by sixteen amazing women, Omicron Delta Zeta (ODZ) has faithfully served the communities of Delray Beach, Boca Raton, Boynton Beach and beyond. ODZ has been recognized internationally, regionally and statewide by Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. for its astounding service in the community. Some of its most notable outreach programs include:

- Hats on Women's Forum- a multigenerational forum for community conversations about issues affecting Black women, girls and their communities.
- Prematurity Awareness Month- a national partnership with March of Dimes to educate the community about Black maternal health and premature birth.
- Adopt-A-School- sponsorship of multiple schools to include Galaxy E3 Elementary, Carver Middle and Village Academy.
- Elder Care- partnership with local nursing homes and retirement communities to educate and provide activities for senior citizens.
- Zetas Have Heart- a heart health initiative to address health concerns as a partner for the South Palm Beach County Go Red for Women community event, Walks in the Park with Palm Beach County Zetas.

In 2003, the Zeta Pearl Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) foundation, was established by ODZ to further enhance its philanthropic commitment to promote youth enrichment, leadership development and scholarship in the community.

- Providing financial support through scholarships to qualifying students in underserved communities. To date, over \$70,000 has been provided to assist high school seniors in achieving their educational and career goals.
- Delivering youth programming aligned with Zeta Phi Beta's national initiatives, including educational enrichment, leadership development, STEAM exposure, health and wellness, mental health, engagement in ecological stewardship, community service, and civic engagement.; and
- Promoting equity in access to higher education and character development in youth.
