THE PROGRAM

The Orcas Community Resource Center's Diaper Bank Program provides diapers, wipes, and essential hygiene items for island families, ensuring that infants and toddlers in our community have access to the supplies necessary for healthy development and well-being.

Participating families receive a one month's supply of diapers and wipes each visit, significantly reducing the financial burden on parents who often must choose between hygiene products and other basic needs like food or utilities.



Your support helped serve 50 local families with over 36,000 diapers in 2025. That's 3,000 diapers per month!
