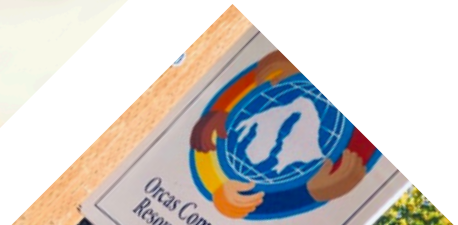

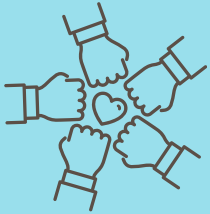

Households are eligible for 7 items + one item per additional household member.

Example: a household of 3 receives 7 items + 2 additional, for a total of 9 items per month.

Ejemplo: un hogar de 3 personas recibe 7 artículos + 2 adicionales, para un total de 9 artículos por mes.
