

Art Life – A Group Invitational Exhibition of Figure Artists Influenced by The Bay Area Figurative Movement

Twenty top Bay Area figurative artists have been invited to participate in an annual group show held at the Sausalito Center for the Arts' expansive gallery.

The Curator works with each artist to select five recent sculptures and/or 2-dimensional art pieces to work as a "show within a show".

The exhibition reflects influences from the Bay Area Figurative Movement within a wide range of styles, techniques, and approaches.

The figure is always central to the work, and most of the artists draw or sculpt from life, portraying our friends and family, our community of art models, or examining the forms and faces of perfect strangers. This show embraces our human nature and individual experience.
