

Entries Being Evaluated For Autorama

Autorama show director, Harold Bagdasarian and his review committee recently started the formidable task of evaluating the qualifications and attractions of nearly 300 customized cars, boats, motorcycles, hot rods and ancient and classic cars whose owners have submitted pre deadline entries for the 21st annual Sacramento Autorama and Motor Sports Review showing Feb. 3 to 7 at Cal Expo.

Bagdasarian said that a maximum of 165 entries can be accepted. They will be separated into 40 classifications within four major divisional groups. Over 130 trophies valued at \$9,000 will be awarded at the close of the show with the divisional sweepstakes trophies each worth \$800.

Already accepted for the motorized extravaganza from among the earliest entrants are such outstanding and unique vehicles as the Bing Crosby Golf Cart which will have its premiere showing in Sacramento; an innovative 1923 Model T hot rod street roadster called the Budget Mobile by Bill Roach, Concord, and the Bugaloo's Buggy, a featured vehicle in the current TV series, "The Bugaloos". Both the Crosby Cart and the Bugaloo's Buggy are the creations of George Barris, Hollywood automotive stylist who attended Sacramento schools.
