Though it's for nighttime, "Lidsville" will include some of the elements the Kroffts favor in their Saturday daytime shows. "Pufnstuf" stars Jack Wild, who played the Artful Dodger in "Oliver." "Lidsville" will offer the screen Oliver himself, Mark Lester. And another old-timer in films, Mickey Rooney, will be part of the blend with the fresh English faces.

"And we're doing a feature movie, too," Krofft said, as if it were necessary.
