The Apprentice will be working alongside the cook and nursery manager, on a variety of tasks listed below:

- Always wear all protective and hygienic clothing (Hat, apron, gloves etc.) This clothing to be removed EACH TIME you leave the building.
- Ensure high quality hygiene before and after all food preparations.
- Keep hair tied back and nails clean and at a reasonable length.
- Prepare lunch, tea and snacks for the children attending nursery.
- All meals are to be nutritious, well – balanced and healthy.
- Ensure all meals are of the right temperature and placed in a safe place in the children's rooms.
- Carry all meals and snacks to the children's rooms.
- Collect trays after mealtimes.
- Clear rooms and kitchen after each meal.
- Always keep kitchen in a clean and tidy condition.
- Complete the Daily Kitchen Check sheet for the day.
- Freezer to be defrosted twice a year.
- Comply with all Environmental Health Regulations at all times.
- Read and comply with the relevant policies and procedures at all times.

- Training will take place at the premises and online.
- An assessor will visit the setting every 3 months to monitor progress.
