In consideration of my membership in the Lauderdale Small Boat Club, Inc. with the benefits derived there from, I do hereby covenant and agree that, in the event fees for dockage of my boat remain unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days after a date upon which such fee is due, the Lauderdale Small Boat Club, Inc. shall have a lien on the described boat which shall attach immediately upon the expiration of such thirty (30) day period and the Lauderdale Small Boat Club, Inc. shall be entitled to exclusive possession of said boat for the purpose of enforcing its lien in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

Signatures below on this application also makes the members aware that, in accordance with the LSBC By-Laws, New Members, Section 4, Item D:

New members, during the first twelve (12) months of their membership in LSBC, shall be required to attend six (6) regular Membership or Board of Directors meetings to earn the privilege of voting in the general elections and work at least twelve (12) Volunteer Work Hours or buy out any of the 12 hours not worked at the rate of \$20 per hour to retain their membership in LSBC.

In subsequent years they must attend four Membership or Board Meetings to retain the privilege to vote in the general elections and work at least twelve (12) Volunteer Work Hours per calendar year or buy out any of the 12 hours not worked at the rate of \$20 per hour to retain their membership in LSBC.

Volunteer Work Hours can be approved by the Director of the area where the member worked, in behalf of the club. All other active members (who joined prior to April 2013) and distinguished members in good standing shall be required to attend four (4) regular Membership or Board of Directors meetings per calendar year to retain the privilege to vote in the general elections.

Any member who cannot attend a regular Membership or Board of Directors meeting may substitute an approved LSBC work day in lieu of attendance at any meeting. It is the member's responsibility to immediately inform the Director of Membership so that the Director of Membership can properly certify the privilege to vote. Failure to immediately notify the Director of Membership will result in the member not receiving credit for his/her approved work. This requirement must be satisfied prior to the date of the general elections.

The attendance or Volunteer Work Hours requirements may be waived for reasons of health or employment obligations, upon application to the Director of Membership, and with the approval of a majority of the Board of Directors.

When someone turns 65 within a calendar year it is up to them as a Member to notify the LSBC board so their next year Volunteer Work Hours may be reflective of their option to work only 1/2 the required time.

The yacht owner shall, at his or her expense maintain minimum vessel liability (protection and Indemnity) with minimum limits of \$300,000 Combined Single limit and hull insurance for the fair market value of the vessel. The policy will name Lauderdale Small Boat Club (LSBC) as an additional insured with waiver of subrogation. The yacht owner further agrees to hold LSBC harmless for any claims involving premises liability or property damage. Yacht owner agrees to provide an annual Certificate of Liability Insurance to Lauderdale Small Boat Club referencing the additional insured status and waiver of subrogation endorsement.

Yacht owner agrees that any 3rd party contractor invited on the premises will provide a certificate of insurance evidencing General Liability insurance with limits of no less than \$1,000,000 and workers compensation prior to commencing any work. Said insurance for the contractor shall name Lauderdale Small Boat Club as an additional insured with waiver of subrogation.

When having a mechanic on the premises to work on your boat, the mechanic MUST check in at the Pilot House BEFORE beginning work on the boat. The mechanic must vacate the premises by 4:30 PM unless the boat owner is present and has let the Dock Master know of his presence prior to the Dock Master's departure at 4:30 PM.
