After more than 120 volunteers contributed over **35,000 hours** to transform the former Lodi Medical Clinic, Reach Out Lodi opened the doors of the Community Store and Community Center at 601 Clark Street on October 30, 2015. From day one, generosity, commitment, and volunteerism have powered everything we doensuring families can meet basic needs and neighbors have a welcoming place to gather, learn, and connect.

- Community Store: Free access to food, personal essentials, clothing, and school supplies—short-term or long-term—plus referrals to energy, housing, and other resources.
- **Community Center**: Four rooms (plus a commercial kitchen) hosting meetings, classes, celebrations, and community events.







Reach Out Lodi is honored to receive a grant from the Lodi Area Community Endowment (LACE) to partially fund our School Supply Program. This initiative ensures that Pre-K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students in the School District of Lodi who need assistance start the year equipped and confident—with the tools for success.

Each summer, ROL volunteers led by Terry Myers, collaborate with district staff to identify students in need, reference each child's classroom supply list, and assemble individualized kits. When needed, students also receive a new backpack so they can walk into the classroom prepared from day one.


