

High Knob Ranch Campground Rules

Quiet Hours 10:00 PM - 7:00 AM

Always be considerate of other campers.

Trailer Sites: Check-In 2:00 PM Check-Out 11:00 AM

Cabins: Check-In 4:00 PM Check-Out 10:00 AM

1. Please be respectful of the next campers arriving at your site by leaving your cabin/campsite tidy.
2. No smoking in any cabins or buildings.
3. Free wifi is available in/near the camp store.
4. **We are on city water. Please limit the use of water to help us keep your camping fees reasonable.** Water use is prohibited for truck/trailer washing, swimming pools, water/sprinkler toys, etc..
5. Do not hose animals off at your campsite. There are 3 Horse/Mule wash stations available around camp for your use. 4 minutes of water use for \$1.00 in quarters. (Quarters can be purchased at the camp store.)
6. **Please be a responsible pet owner!! Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times within the campground.** Camper's dogs are not allowed inside the store. Pet owners MUST immediately clean up animal waste everywhere within the campground – whether on your campsite or elsewhere. **No pooping without scooping!!** Pet waste should not be left in any occupied/unoccupied campsites at any time. No exceptions!! Please dispose of pet waste in manure bunkers, trash containers or dumpsters only.
7. If we're made aware of barking dogs, dogs that show aggression or dogs that cause a disturbance, we will ask that you find alternative arrangements for them away from camp.
8. No animals of any kind can be tied to water hydrants, electric posts, building posts or utility poles.
9. Do not throw trash – plastic, bottles, cans, foil, clothing, etc. in fire pits or porta potties.
10. Place all trash in bags and deposit into the provided dumpsters by the camp store or haul it home with you.
11. **Please be respectful of us and our local neighbors.** Drive slowly to help reduce dust on the roads and in camp and DO NOT dump your waste tanks on any roads in or near camp.
12. Proof of negative Coggins tests are required for all horses/mules entering camp. Clean health certifications within 30 days are required for all out of state horses/mules.
13. Please report any needed repairs to camp owners. Repairs should be done by High Knob personnel only!
14. Only 1 animal per stall/pen is allowed.
15. All Stalls/Pens/Picket Line areas must be cleaned upon departure. NO EXCEPTIONS.
16. Only temporary stalls/pens provided by the campground are allowed.
17. No tying or penning horses in camp or on trails where they can damage trees. Hobble, cross-tie between trees or use provided picket lines when stopping along the trails.
18. Do not leave horses tied to trailers within the campsite for long periods or overnight. Use picket line or stalls/pens only.
19. You are responsible for any damage to campsites and stalls.
20. No tying of hay bags and buckets on the stall gates.
21. Unruly stallions will need to be removed from camp.
22. No discharging of firearms on High Knob Ranch Campground property. Any use of fireworks or firearms is strictly prohibited.
23. Paper lanterns and release of balloons are strictly prohibited.
24. No tent camping is allowed in camp.
25. Please preserve the trail system by staying on DESIGNATED TRAILS ONLY.

Please pack out EVERYTHING you pack into the Shawnee National Forest. We greatly appreciate anyone that collects and properly disposes of trash found along the trails. It's important to us to keep our local trail system clean and keep the forest beautiful for future generations to enjoy!!
