Program Description

York Adams Academy provides an innovative individualized approach to learning that assists students in attaining academic proficiency as they earn their high school diploma.

Students may apply for entrance to the program at any time of the year and finish when all of their high school graduation requirements are met.

York Adams Academy's program allows students great flexibility in establishing a learning pace that meets their individual needs by attending one three hour session per day while students continue working and/or fulfilling their individual/family responsibilities

York Adams Academy's individualized and competency-based instructional program encourages the student to take the necessary time to complete course requirements provided that academic progress is demonstrated.

Two graduation ceremonies are held per year at York Adams Academy. The first is in December for fall graduates. The second is in June for spring graduates. Both graduations are held at the York Learning Center auditorium. Graduates receive a dual diploma that is awarded on behalf of the students' home district and York Adams Academy.

Eligibility of Students

- Students must be between the ages of 17 and 20 years
- Must be a resident of one of the participating school districts
- Must be recommended by the home school district to attend
 - Must take and pass the YAA Entrance
 Assessment
- Must have zero Safe Schools reportable discipline infractions
- Must have completed approximately 10 credits
