Frequently Asked Questions

When and where will my cap & gown portraits taken?

Cap & gown portrait sittings will be on Tuesday, December 10th (snow date December 17th), immediately before the graduation ceremony. We will be in the same room where you will be getting ready. **Those whose last name begins with A-M can get their photo taken starting at 5:30, N-Z starting at 6:00.** We will end at 6:30.

What should I bring for my cap & gown portraits?

We ask that you be in both your cap and your gown when waiting for your turn. Please also have your form filled out and payment option ready to help cut down wait times for everyone. We will have extra forms available for anyone who may need one.

How many formal cap & gown photos will you take?

We will take two shots of you standing in front of the formal portrait backdrop. If you blink, don't worry! We'll make sure we get one of you looking your best. The best one will be chosen for your package.

What should I do about hair/makeup?

While we love to see people express their own personalities and styles, less is more in this case. Extra heavy makeup does not typically photograph well, so we suggest light applications and more neutral styles. Consider your cap when styling your hair.

Will my formal cap & gown portrait be retouched?

We will perform a light retouch on your formal cap & gown portrait. Retouching typically includes skin blemishes, teeth whitening, stray hairs, and glasses glares. If you're worried about a breakout, let us know instead of trying to cover it up with too much makeup. Please note that candid photos taken during the ceremony are not retouched.

Where can I find ceremony photos from the graduation ceremony, and when will they be posted?

Ceremony photos will also be posted on www.egphotostudio.com. We typically post around 2 weeks after the event. We will make an announcement when they are online, and you may also pre-register on the event gallery to be notified when they are posted.

Can I order online?

Absolutely! Ceremony photos and cap & gown portraits will both be available for online purchase/reorder. Students who have their cap & gown portraits taken will receive a password to view their personal photo.
