## Travel Guide to Longhill High School (BN2 7FR)

Welcome to the visitor travel guide for Longhill High School, located on Falmer Road in Rottingdean, Brighton, East Sussex, BN2 7FR. This comprehensive guide details bus, driving, and walking routes from surrounding towns and villages to help you plan your journey effectively.

### 1. Bus Routes

Longhill High School is well-served by public bus networks across Brighton & Hove and East Sussex. Key services operating directly along Falmer Road include the 2, 2A, 22, and 52.

Origin	Primary Bus Services	Key Details & Route Path
Rottingdean	2, 2A, 22, 52	Direct routes heading north up Falmer Road. Journey time is approximately 3-5 minutes from the high street.
Saltdean	12, 12A, 14, 27 (Connect to 2, 2A, 22)	Take a coastal service west to Rottingdean High Street / A259 crossroads, then transfer to a northbound Falmer Road bus (2, 2A, 22).

Origin	Primary Bus Services	Key Details & Route Path
<b>Ovingdean</b>	52 (Direct) or local walking connection	The 52 connects Ovingdean directly to Longhill High School via Ovingdean Road and Falmer Road.
<b>Woodingdean</b>	2, 2A, 22, 52	Direct southbound routes down Falmer Road towards Rottingdean. Journey takes approximately 5 minutes from Woodingdean central crossroads.
<b>Peacehaven</b>	12, 12A, 14 (Connect to 2, 2A, 22)	Take any coaster service westbound along the A259 to Rottingdean, then change to a northbound bus up Falmer Road.
<b>Newhaven</b>	12, 12A, 12X (Connect to 2, 2A, 22)	Take the Coaster service from Newhaven town centre westbound along the A259 to Rottingdean, then change to the northbound Falmer Road services.
<b>Brighton</b>	2, 2A, 22 (Direct)	Frequent direct buses run from Brighton city centre (Old Steine / Churchill Square). Route 2/2A runs via Eastern Road; Route 22 runs via Elm Grove and Woodingdean.

Origin	Primary Bus Services	Key Details & Route Path
<b>Hove</b>	2, 2A (Direct) or 1, 6 (Connect in Brighton)	The 2 and 2A run directly from Hove through central Brighton out to the school. Alternatively, take any frequent central bus and change at the Old Steine.
<b>Shoreham</b>	700 Coastliner (Connect to 2, 2A, 22)	Take the 700 east to Brighton city centre (Old Steine), then catch a direct 2, 2A, or 22 bus out to the school.
<b>Lewes</b>	28, 29 (Connect at Falmer)	Take the 28 or 29 westbound towards Brighton, disembark at Falmer Station, and switch to a southbound Route 52 or 2 bus towards Woodingdean/Rottingdean.

## 2. Driving Routes & Access

Longhill High School is situated on the B2123 (Falmer Road), providing straightforward vehicular access from major arterial roads like the A27 and the A259 coast road.

- **From Rottingdean:** Drive north on the B2123 (Falmer Road) for roughly 1 mile. The school entrance will be clearly visible on your left.
- **From Saltdean / Peacehaven / Newhaven:** Take the A259 westbound into Rottingdean. At the main traffic lights (by the white windmill sign), turn right onto the B2123 (Falmer Road) and head north for 1 mile.
- **From Ovingdean:** Follow Ovingdean Road eastbound out of the village until it reaches the junction with the B2123 (Falmer Road). Turn right (south) onto Falmer Road; the school is a short distance down on the right.
- **From Woodingdean:** Head south along the B2123 (Falmer Road) from the central Woodingdean crossroads. The school is located about 1.5 miles south on the right-hand side.
- **From Brighton / Hove / Shoreham:** Head eastbound along the A259 marine parade past the Marina. Continue until you reach the traffic lights at Rottingdean, then turn left onto

the B2123 (Falmer Road) and drive north for 1 mile. Alternatively, take the A27 eastbound, exit at the Falmer/University junction, and take the B2123 south through Woodingdean.

- **From Lewes:** Take the A27 westbound toward Brighton. Exit at the Falmer/University junction, take the first left at the roundabout onto the B2123, and follow it south straight through Woodingdean until you reach the school.

### 3. Walking & Cycling Routes

For visitors, staff, and students living locally, walking routes to the campus are accessible via safe pavements, designated crossings, and public footpaths.

- **From Rottingdean (Approx. 15-20 mins):** Walk north from the village pond along the continuous paved pedestrian footway on the western side of Falmer Road. There is a steady incline heading up towards the school gates.
- **From Ovingdean (Approx. 10-15 mins):** Walk east along Ovingdean Road, utilizing the pavement. At the junction with Falmer Road, cross safely and head south to the main entrance. There is also a public bridleway/footpath across the fields connecting Ovingdean directly to the rear of the school fields.
- **From Woodingdean (Approx. 25-35 mins):** Walk south down Falmer Road from the downs tracking path or the roadside pavements. The route is downhill coming from Woodingdean towards the school.
- **From Saltdean (Approx. 40-50 mins):** Pedestrians can walk west along the Undercliff Walk or the A259 pavement to Rottingdean, then turn north up Falmer Road. Alternatively, confident walkers can utilize the public downland footpaths heading north-west from upper Saltdean across the downs towards the B2123.

*Note: Visitors arriving by car are advised to check parking availability with the school reception in advance, especially during peak school hours.*
