

## FUN Day 2019 FAQ

### 1. What should my child bring?

- a. Wear their class color t-shirt to school
- b. Sunscreen/Hats suggested
- c. Their own bagged lunch if they don't want pizza. They also have the option to buy from a limited menu from Whitson's in the cafeteria
- d. Backpacks Not Necessary

### 2. What will the PTA provide?

- a. **Leopard Paw Print Tattoos**- class reps will help apply tattoos on any child that would like them in the morning before Fun Day events begin. Tattoos are not required
- b. **Snack- Goldfish** snack will be handed out to all classes during their designated snack time. An **allergy compliant popcorn snack** is available for any child with a gluten or dairy allergy. **Fla-Vor-Ice pops** will be handed out to children during the 5<sup>th</sup> grade Tug-of-War. 5<sup>th</sup> graders will eat ice pops during their time at the dunk tank.
- c. **Water**- Water Stations are set up outside all around school grounds and will be available for everyone throughout the day
- d. **Lunch**- Children will be inside in the Leopards Den for lunchtime. We will serve **pizza** (from Luigis, Attilios and Gianni's) watermelon, Capri Suns and water. **Students still have the option to bring their own lunch or if necessary, purchase from a limited Whitsons menu in the cafeteria.**

### 3. Can parents come to Fun Day?

- a. We welcome all parents that are PTA members, have signed up to lend their time in some way as a volunteer at the event **AND have completed their state mandated HIB training no later than 5/29/19.** This ensures we know exactly who is on our school premise throughout the day.
- b. A list of all event volunteers and class reps/replacements will be at the check-in table in the front of the school. All volunteers will be given a wristband and only people with wristbands will be allowed on school grounds. Non-Lincroft Students including older or younger siblings are not allowed to attend Fun Day.

### 4. What additional security measures are taken?

- a. **District Security Guards** will patrol the front/back grounds and the building throughout the day.
- b. **Access into School**
  - i. **Courtyard Doors**- A co-teacher will be stationed here and is only allowed to give access to class representatives, PTA Board members and Fun Day event chairs. Reasons for entry may be to escort children to the bathroom, the school nurse and for lunchtime. The co-teacher will have a walkie talkie to communicate with the front office if necessary.
  - ii. **Main Doors** – All other volunteers are discouraged from entering the building for any reason. However, parents who do require access must buzz into the office at the main entrance as per the normal daily

procedure.

**5. Can parents use the bathroom?**

- a. A Port-o-Potty is available in the back of the school to the right of the baseball field. Port-o-Potty Bathrooms are also available in the Little League Field next door.

**6. What is the dismissal procedure?**

- a. **Friday, May 31st is a normal full day schedule.** Once the Fun Day activities are finished, teachers and students will enter the building at 2:30 and go back to the classrooms. **Dismissal will be as normal at 3 pm. If parents plan to pick up their children at 3 pm, they must send a note to the teacher in the MORNING**

**7. Any documents I need to send or bring with me on the day?**

- a. **5<sup>th</sup> Grade Parents- A Tug-of-War Permission Slip** will be sent home with your child shortly. Please fill out and sign to ensure your child can participate in this event
- b. A **Schedule of Events by Grade** and a **Grounds Map** are included in this email. Please print and bring with you on the day of Fun Day. This will help you locate where you need to volunteer or the location of your child's grade throughout the day.
