DYknow Platform: Mr Siwiak

- Virtual Classroom Management used since 2018- monitor student activity in real time
- Permissions are granted based on the child's schedule & only during school hours
- Available in all schools during all grades
- Teachers see thumbnails of each student screen
- Block/Allow Only function: for single, group, or class: beneficial for testing online
- Student Understanding function: raise hand without a student hesitation
- Attention function: lock screens- teachers must remove, time lapse, or class runs out
- URL push function: send links directly to each students screen
- Activity Tracker based on class periods, students, full student population
