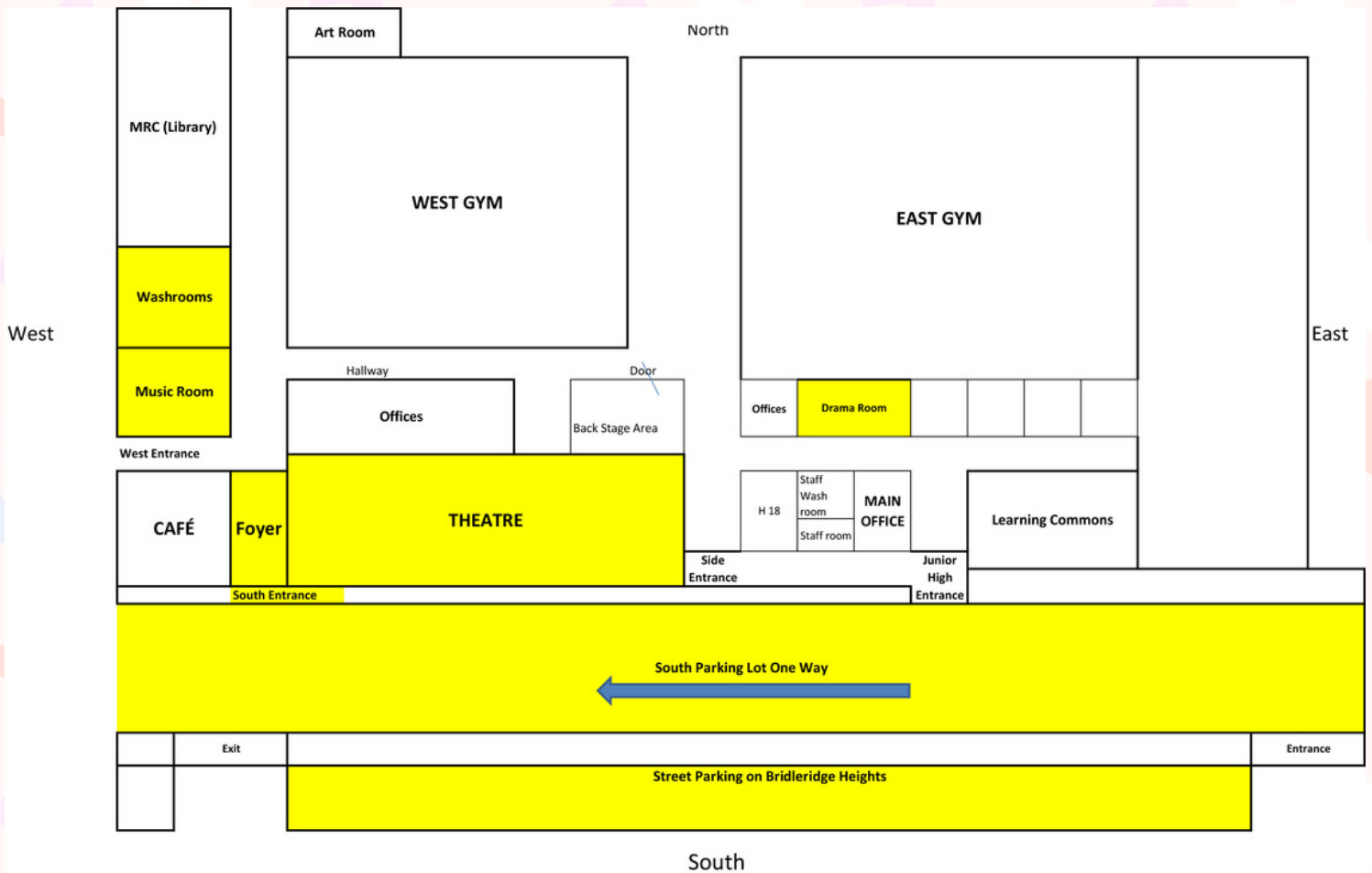

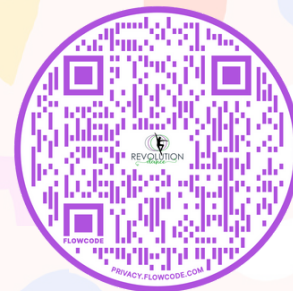

Recital Tickets

When will Recital tickets go on sale?

Recital tickets will go on sale Friday April 15, 2022

Tickets are not available at the door as our shows always sell out.

Can I purchase tickets at Revolution Dance?

All Tickets must be purchased through our website www.RevolutionDanceCalgary.com

How much do tickets cost?

Early Bird Tickets until May 31 are \$20.00 each plus GST.

After June 1 Tickets are \$30.00 each plus GST.

ALL SIBLINGS MUST HAVE A TICKET if attending the show.

Will the seats be socially distanced?

At this time seating will not be socially distanced. We recommend anyone concerned about Social Distancing attend the Thursday evening show.

Will there be a livestream option to watch the show?

Due to additional cost we do not provide a livestream to the show. A downloadable link to the recital can be purchased at the time tickets are purchased. The Link will be emailed within 2 weeks of the show.

Is there a limit on the number of tickets I can purchase?

We do not limit the number of tickets a family may purchase, as we need to sell as many tickets as possible to cover the theater Rental cost.

Can my dancer watch the show in the audience with me?

As entering and exiting the Theater creates a disturbance to other audience members, all dancers must remain backstage for the entire recital.

Is there a chance that the show my dancer is in will sell out?

Yes, our shows always sell out, so please place your order as soon as possible. Tickets are sold on a first come, first serve bases.

If I have issues with the ticket buying process, who do I contact?

Will my seats be reserved or general admission?

We would like to create an organized and professional atmosphere, all tickets are non-reserved seating, doors will open 15 minutes before each show time, this is a first come first serve seating. Each member of your party must have a ticket to enter the theatre regardless of age. No children will be allowed to sit on a parents lap due to Fire Code Regulations.

When can I enter the Venue on the day of the show?

Theater Doors will open 15 minutes prior to Curtain Time.

Please Do not enter the theater when music is playing.

If my dancer is in multiple shows can I attend both shows?

Yes, you may attend both shows, However, you must purchase tickets for both shows. Tickets to the Friday Show will only be issued 1 week prior to the recital after all parents have had a chance to purchase tickets.

Audience Etiquette

Here are a few etiquette guidelines to help you and your fellow audience members enjoy the show fully.

Everyone Needs a Ticket – Parents, Toddlers, Grandparents, Friends. Everyone attending the recital needs to purchase a ticket and seats are limited. While children are welcome to attend they must remain seated during the performances. If you feel that your child may not be able to remain focused for the performances it is recommended that they do not attend.

Silence or Turn off Your Devices – Please turn off cell phones; tablets, and any other electronic devices prior to the performance starting. You should never speak, text, or play games on your electronic devices during a performance. You should also not check your device during a performance since the backlight is incredibly bright and distracting to other audience members and is also visible to the dancers on stage.

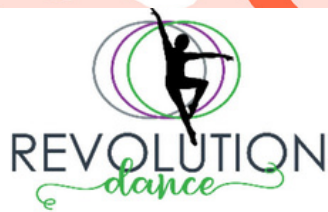
No Entrance / Exits – Our recital is designed to flow quickly between performance pieces. Please do not enter or exit unless it is an emergency. If you have a fussy child please exit as quietly as possible in order to minimize the disruption to your fellow audience members.

No Video or Pictures – In conjunction with Copyright and Child Safety Laws, personal photography or Video recording is strictly prohibited. We have employed a professional Videographers to capture these memories for you! Place your order at www.RevolutionDanceCalgary.com Cost \$45.00 for both the Winter and Spring Recital video and Spring Studio photos.

Curtain Call – The performance is over at the conclusion of curtain call (When every dancer comes onstage to take their final bow). Audience members should stay for the entire performance and should not leave early during the curtain call. Please stay in your seat until the performance is over and the house lights are raised. Then, exit with the rest of the audience. This policy is in place to show respect and appreciation to all of our performers.

No Backstage Access – No one is allowed backstage except for dancers, volunteers, and instructors. Dancers will be released from change rooms following the curtain call. No dancers will be released at intermission or at any other time throughout the recital. Please rest assured that we have a number of Staff backstage to help your dancer throughout the entire process.

Enjoy the Show! – This one is the most important, sit back, relax and enjoy the performances. The dancers have worked hard on these performances and they love hearing the audience's enthusiasm and applause.

The Big Day!

This is the big day your dancer has worked for ! Your dancer will be every excited and it's going to be so much fun to take the stage and perform! We want to make this experience the best it can be for you and your dancer so please continue to read all the details below carefully

When do I need to arrive at the theater?

Dancers need to arrive in full costume at 5:30 p.m.
Show starts at 6:00 p.m.

Where do I drop off my dancer?

All Recreational Dancers - Music Room
All Competitive Dancers - Drama Room

Who can drop off my dancer?

We ask that only one parent or guardian drop off your dancer and all other guest wait in the theater Lobby.

Should my dancer arrive at the venue in costume?

Yes, Dancers should arrive at the venue in costume with hair and makeup completed. Please do not feed your dancers once they are in costumes as dancers with stained costumes will not be allowed on stage.

Don't forget your dance shoes and a non leaking water bottle.

What Should I Bring?

All dancers must bring a labelled bag with extra hair spray, brush, hair elastics, bobby pins.

Don't forget your costumes, tights and shoes

FOOD AND DRINK: Costumes are easily ruined by food and drink stains. Please only pack water in a non leaking water bottle. Stained costumes are subject to a \$100 replacement Fee.

Children are discouraged from bring any valuables including phones, Ipods, Ipads and Laptops as the venue and Revolution Dance will not take responsibility for any items lost, damaged or stolen

Will my dancer be able to watch the show?

No, dancers will not be able to watch the show. We encourage families to purchase the Recital video so dancers may see the dances. Due to Child Privacy and Copyright Laws Video Taping of the show is strictly prohibited.

Can I go backstage or to the dressing room to assist my dancer in between routines?

No, Parents are not allowed in the dressing rooms for any reason. Entering and Exiting the Theater is a distraction for other Audience Members.

Dismissal Policy & Procedures:

At the end of Curtain Call please only send one parent or gradian to the hallway beside the theater. Dancers will be released from the Dressing Room. We ask that parents not enter the Dressing Rooms to prevent congestion and overwhelming dancers when they can't find their parent. For Safety of the dancers, Dancers will only be dismissed at the end of the recital

Stage Makeup and Hair

Does my dancer need to wear makeup for Dress Rehearsal and the Recital?

Yes! The lights on the stage are very bright, and the Theater is large! All dancers will need to wear makeup for the show. This will make their beautiful faces stand out on stage and not be washed out by the lights.

For the younger dancers, we suggest light blush to match their skin, light brown eyeshadow and red lips. Competitive and Teen dancers should wear blush, Red Lipstick, Brown Smoke eye makeup and false eyelashes. All dancers should look their best for the big day!

How do I style my dancer's hair for Dress Rehearsal and the Recital?

For uniformity, all dancers are required to wear a Ballet Bun at the nape of their neck with a hair net. Please no sock buns. Hair should be as neat and clean as possible. This is a special day, so you should make a special effort to help your dancer look their best! Use gel / clips / hairspray to smooth fly-aways so that all dancers have a classy and uniform look on stage! Bags should be pulled back.
