Important: Water Service Interruption within March 14-March 17, 2025, Due to Construction Work.

Dear UWCD Pumping Trough Pipeline Users,

We're writing to inform you of a scheduled construction project within the United Water Conservation District's infrastructure, specifically concerning the Pumping Trough Pipeline (PTP). We initially sent a notice to PTP Users regarding this construction project back on November 20, 2024. This construction is crucial for our water distribution system's long-term supply reliability. Please be advised that service will be interrupted to a limited number of turnouts for up to the entire duration to accommodate the connection of our Recycled Water Interconnection Pipeline to our existing PTP System along Laguna Road. We do not anticipate impacts to service other than the five (5) turnouts listed below.

Scheduled Construction Details:

Date: March 14, 2025 – March 17, 2025

Time: Starting after 8:00 AM 3/14/2025 and expected to conclude by 7:00 PM 3/17/2025.

Affected Area: Service area 3700 Block of Laguna Road to 4320 Block of Laguna Road

Purpose: Connection of our Recycled Water Interconnection Pipeline Project to our existing system along Laguna Road.

Impact: The following five (5) Pumping Trough Pipeline Turnouts will be affected during this period:

- **Laguna Road Area:** Turnouts 114, 125, 126, 127, 162

Benefits: This construction project is crucial for enhancing our system's supply reliability.

Actions Required: Please take any necessary steps to prepare for this temporary service interruption.
