VIKING VALLEY 2025 LEAGUE RULES

The VVHC Sporting Clay League will be organized for a 5-10 person team as well as a 3-person team. For the 5-10 person league, the top 5 scores will count. For the 3- person league, the top 2 scores will count. An individual may shoot with more than one team in the league. We will use a modified Lewis Class System. Your team may re-shoot any league shoot if they wish, as long as the re-shoot occurs before the end of the <u>current league month</u>, and <u>you must use your most recent score</u>. Each month's course gets progressively more challenging. The cost for league shooting is \$22 per 50 sporting clay round.

MISSED SHOOTS MAY BE MADE UP BY TEAMS OR INDIVIDUALS, AND MUST BE MADE UP BEFORE THE END OF THE CURRENT LEAGUE MONTH. NO EXCEPTIONS.

The registration fee for the 5-10 person league is \$40, and the 3-person league fee is \$30. A completed registration form must be filled out for each team, and must include full names of each registered shooter with a contact phone number, and address for the team captain. Score sheets must also be filled out with first and last names to make sure scores are posted correctly. Only shooters that are on your team registration are eligible to score for your team. Early registration is appreciated.

If you would like the same shooting schedule each month, please schedule at the beginning of the season. This is a great way to plan ahead, and makes it easier for your team to know when you're shooting.

- Our spring/summer office hours will be: Monday 10:00 am- 7:00 pm, Tuesday: CLOSED, Wednesday-Friday: 10:00 am- 7:00 pm, Saturday: 9:00 am- 4:00 pm, Sunday: 12:00 pm- 4:00 pm.
- All shooting is by **reservation only**. Please respect your team and other shooters by being on time. If your team is not here at the scheduled time and the next group is ready, they will be allowed to start before you.

Remember, a legal hit is a chip. Dust is not considered a dead bird. You may load only 2 shells in your gun at any time, and load only when you are in a shooting stand. Only one set of "show me" birds is allowed at each station, so please pay attention. If you do not see a thrown bird, it is considered a lost bird.
