

Presidio Golf Course

Presidio Golf Course, 300 Finley Road, San Francisco 94129, United States



One of the oldest courses on the West coast, the Presidio Golf Course has a storied history.

It was built in 1895 when Colonel William M. Graham, the Presidio's commander at the time, allowed a group of businessmen known as the San Francisco Golf and Country Club to create a nine-hole course within the post. Greens fees were just 50 cents. The Presidio's signature trees were at first absent, since the huge stands of eucalyptus and Monterey pine had not fully grown in.

Presidio Golf Course has hosted some of the world's most famous golfers. Babe Ruth, Bob Hope, Bing Crosby, Charles Schulz, and Joe DiMaggio played here

TPC Harding Park, 99 Harding Road, San Francisco 94132, United States



Formerly known as Harding Park Golf Club and referred to as Harding Park by the regulars, this municipal golf course is owned by the city and county of San Francisco. Named after avid golfer and former President Warren G. Harding, the golf course was designed by Willie Watson (who also designed the Olympic Club) and opened in 1925.

TPC Harding Park features 27 holes of championship golf – the 18-hole Harding Park Course and the 9-hole Fleming Course. The course will host the PGA Championship in 2020.

TPC Harding Park has been honored as the "#13 Municipal Golf Course in the United States," as well as the "#24 Best Course to Play in California," by Golfweek Magazine. Golf Digest Magazine has also named it as, "one of the Best Places to Play," ranking it a 4.5 star golf course.
