ADIEU — BOB

At 11.30 a.m. on Wednesday, the 6th of April, Robert Stanley (Bob) Cook was borne with reverence and singular honour to his last resting place on the shoulders of six of his Comrades in Arms, whilst a score or more, medals bright, and Battalion Colours at every neck, formed a solid Guard of Honour, in paying respect to a Fourth Battalion man on his Last Parade.

His first parade as a White over Green man was in 1935, at Merrylands Drill Hall, in a Battalion called the 4/3 Infantry Battalion. He wore no other colour, ever. His pride in his colours, his battalion, his comrades, in infantry and in himself as a soldier serving others, could well serve us, his comrades, as a yardstick difficult to attain; to others as an unqualified example of the finest, cleanest thing we touched in a sullied, selfish world.

He was the first of us to wear the Colour. He was with the first to represent his home-town, Fairfield. He was with the first advance party of the 2/4th which sailed in December, 1939, several weeks before the main body. He was the first Australian to instruct at Sarafand, the English training headquarters in Palestine. He was with the first to advise, help and father the younger, wilder, headstrong ones.

He was Sergeant Bob Cook.

It could have been Bob Cook who said:
"Oh! I have grasped the friendly bonds of earth,
and hugged her folds from laughter-silvered wings,
Hellwards I've shied, away from crumbling steel and dirt,

to grasp at life, and think a million things,
you cannot dream of — reeled as roar of steel has rung,
in mounting nameless horror there.

I've raced with eager mental steed, and flung
my useless body freed from earthly care,
Down, down to tears, to laughter ringing true,
I've wrapped the cloak of silence to my face,
where even, warrior steel is bright — and new
and while with silent lifting mind I've trod,
The forge, the temper mould, with grace,
Put out both hands — and touched the face of God."

So Bob, on Wednesday, put out both hands and grasped the Hand of God. The Kid.

BATTALION HISTORY

As this "White Over Green" will be the one read before Anzac Day when so many of us will meet once again, I should like to write a few lines about the progress of the History and suggest ways in which individual members of the Association can help the Committee in its task.

Firstly, complete the enclosed ballot paper as soon as possible. At the same time contact as many non-financial members of the Association as you are able and have them do the same. Time is now important as the Minister for the Army recently has issued the following statement in connection with Unit War History Grants: "Grants towards the publication of Unit War Histories will cease at the end of this year. This was

announced today by the Minister for the Army, Mr. J. O. Cramer. The Military Board has decided that sufficient time has now elapsed since the creation of the Unit War History Trust Fund, in 1944, for all interested Units and Unit Associations to have taken advantage of the grants. No further applications would be accepted after December 31, 1960."

Secondly, advise immediately your own or any other address which you know to be incorrect in the List of Members, which goes forward in this issue of White Over Green.

Thirdly, let us have your regimental number. It is hoped the History will include a Nominal Roll of those who served with the Unit. As there is no definite list as such we are obliged to obtain this information from various sources. The War Diary, Routine Orders, General Routine Orders, private papers and individuals are some of the sources already that have been used. (Massa Brooks is recording details on a card filing system.)

Fourthly, write down and send to the Committee any incidents that you recall. We have a lot of detail from the Middle East, but about nothing from the Northern Territory, The Tablelands and New Guinea.

To date I have been able to copy the War Diary from the formation of the Battalion until its return to Adelaide.

I tentatively have divided this period into the following chapters: Formation of the Battalion, voyage to the Middle East, 16th Bde. days at Julis, 19th Bde. XVY A/A Regiments, Kilo 89, into Battle, Tobruk, Derna, Benghazi, and return, Greece, Crete, Palestine, Syria and return to Australia. Obviously, alterations will be required as we progress, but this will serve as a guide to those who would like to record any personal incidents. I am now dealing with the Darwin period.

I will be present at the Association Observances on Anzac Day when I will be able to answer any queries that may be raised by members about the progress of the History. Also, I could collect any personal papers that members might care to make available to me. These will be returned once I have had them copied.
