ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION

Policy 6173

The Board of Education will take immediate steps to provide alternative instruction to pupils who are unable to attend school due to medical, emotional, or disciplinary problems in accordance with law.

Students requiring alternative instruction will receive two hours of instruction per day in addition to Individual Education Program (IEP) mandated services (no holidays or weekends), unless a lesser period is requested by the parent/guardian and is supported by documentation submitted by the student's treating healthcare provider.

Students will receive credit for work completed while on alternative instruction.

Provisions for alternative instruction will be made upon referral to the individual designated by the Superintendent of Schools following the guidelines established by law and the Superintendent of Schools or their designee for placing a student on alternative instruction.
