A. PERSONNEL – MRS. KIMBERLY WHEELER

1. BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby appoints Samantha Ponzio, effective September 1, 2021, as an Elementary Classroom Teacher holding a Certificate for Early Childhood Education (Birth-Grade 2), and Childhood Education (Grades 1-6), for a 4-year probationary period. Her probation expiration will be August 31, 2025*. Compensation will be at Step 1 MA in accordance with the current negotiated agreement between the Valley Stream Teachers' Association and the Board of Education.

*To be eligible to receive tenure, the probationer must receive composite or overall APPR ratings of either effective or highly effective in at least three of the four preceding years, and if the probationer receives an ineffective composite or overall APPR rating in the final year of the probationary period she will not be eligible for tenure at that time.

2. BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby appoints Brian Frey, effective September 1, 2021, as a Part-time (.5) Physical Education Teacher holding a Certificate for Physical Education. Compensation for this appointment will be at Step 1 BA in accordance with the current negotiated agreement between the Valley Stream Teachers' Association and the Board of Education.

X. NEW BUSINESS

1.
