- To avoid any possible conflict of interest, current MISA Officers, Board Members, and Awards Committee members are not eligible.
- Nominations for individual and team projects are available.
- IT projects must have been completed within the 2024 year (January-December).

Nominations can be submitted beginning spring 2025, and the deadline for nominations is August 4, 2025. Nominators or Nominees are not required to be a MISA member.
