Since that time, Diane felt impressed of God to move further in ministry and then began Nurturing Oppressed Women Around the World Ministries, where she has been assigned to women who are hurting because of burgeoning circumstances that have occurred in their lives, that they are ashamed of and feel too ashamed to talk about. Diane has been assigned by God to serve them and help them to obtain their God-given purpose no matter what their past may hold. Diane's ministry is a ministry of healing and reconciliation. One of her favorite scriptures is:

Complex PTSD~The result of ongoing or long term sexual, physical and/or emotional abuse during childhood according to Dr. Maria D. Reyes, Psy.D, LMHC.NCC- November 14, 2019.

The Lord told me I had PTSD. I researched its meaning and certainly I did identify with “Complex PTSD.” Childhood Complex PTSD is an act of betrayal and in many cases, children are threatened not to tell anyone about what is happening to them. This causes depression, anxiety and suicidal impulses. Then the psychological effects continue to plague their lives in the form of Complex PTSD. This includes:

- Fearfulness
- Hypervigilance
- Avoidance of people, places and situations
- Intrusive thoughts & memories
- Volatile mood
- Nightmares
- Flashbacks

- Depression
- Anger
- Suicidal thoughts
- Hopelessness
- Insomnia

People with Complex PTSD are crippled by shame and despair and hold beliefs that the abuse was their fault and resort to self-destructive behaviors and emotional disorders. There are natural and physiological treatments for PTSD, our soul and our spirit needs healing as well and that comes from Jesus Christ our Savior.
