"The Favor of Zion" evening celebration on May 9 with notable speakers and music guest (to be announced) is included in your tour price.

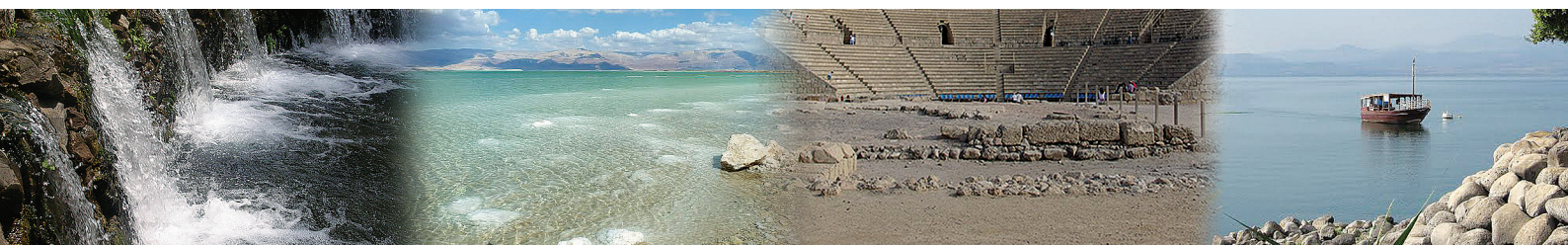
This tour is an excellent option for newcomers and experienced travelers alike.

Day 1 – May 2nd (Tuesday) Arrival in Tel Aviv

- Meeting place: Dan Panorama, Tel Aviv
- **Tel Aviv** - home to one of the oldest harbors in the world. Reception, orientation, and rest.

Day 2 – May 3rd (Wednesday) Central Coast & Jezreel Valley

- Visit **Caesarea** by the Sea, Herod's capital during the Roman reign, and travel through the beautiful Jezreel Valley.
 - Take in the views of **Mount Carmel** where Elijah called down fire from heaven from the epic observation point overlooking the Valley of Armageddon (**Megiddo**).
- If time permits, we will drive through **Nazareth**, the hometown of Jesus, and then **Cana** before our group checks into our Galilean hotel for dinner and overnight rest.

Day 3 – May 4th (Thursday) The Northern Reaches of the Promised Land and Baptismal

- A nature walk through the **Tel Dan Reserve** leads us to the famous site of Jeroboam's Altar, and from there we continue on to the **Banias Springs** and the archeological site of **Caesarea Philippi** where we will remember the Lord's question to His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?"
- We conclude the day with baptismal at the beautiful **Yardenit Baptismal Site**. Overnight in the Galilee.

Day 4 – May 5th (Friday) The Sea of Galilee

- We will visit the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount.
- From this remarkable place, we will continue to visit **Tabgha** where it is believed that the miracle of the fish and the loaves took place, and **Capernaum**, the headquarters of Jesus' Galilean ministry.
- An inspiring **time of worship** on the **Sea of Galilee** will help us gain a First Century experience of Jesus' time.
 - We will conclude this amazing day in **Magdala**, the archeological biblical site of the **Village of Migdal**, the hometown of Mary Magdalene, and then return to our hotel for dinner and overnight rest in the Galilee.

Day 5 – May 6th (Saturday) Along the Jordan River

- Traveling south through the **Jordan Valley** along the Jordanian/Israeli border, discover **Qasr-El-Yahood** (Jesus' original baptism site).
- Heading to the lowest point on earth, visit the epic freedom fortress of **Masada**.
 - Afterward, we will relax in the mineral-rich waters of the **Dead Sea**.
 - As time permits, visit **Jericho**, one of the oldest cities on earth.
 - Overnight: Dead Sea

Day 6 – May 7th (Sunday) The Holy City and Bethlehem

- Today we will begin the day atop the **Mount of Olives** with its magnificent view of the walled city of Jerusalem and walk down to the **Garden of Gethsemane** for a special time of prayer.
- Our next stop will be the **City of David**, where ongoing excavations reveal amazing details of thousands of years of history.
 - From there, we will board the bus to **Bethlehem**, Jesus' birthplace
 - Hotel: Ramada

Day 7 – May 8th (Monday) Old City and Garden Tomb

- We start the day in the **Upper Room** with a visit to the **Tomb of David** and **Jaffa Gate** area.
 - Walk through the **Jewish Quarter** to the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**, **Pool of Bethesda** and the **Western Wall**.
- Exit through the **Damascus Gate** to the **Garden Tomb** where we will experience Holy Communion together.
 - Hotel: Ramada

Day 8 – May 9th (Tuesday) CFI, “Favor of Zion” Celebration

- CFI Tour - meet the leadership and volunteers.
- Lunch and shopping at the Shuk Mahane Yehuda.
- 6:00 to 9:00 **“The Favor of Zion Celebration”** (Ramada)

Day 9 – May 10th (Wednesday)

- **Yad Vashem**
- Free Time
- Preparation for departure
- Final overnight in Jerusalem

Day 10 – May 11th (Thursday) Return to home
