No.	Subject	Discussion
1.	Fundraising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elite Hail Systems providing information on a fundraiser they will be doing with the football team and provided referral cards. They provide discounts on labor to cover insurance deductibles. This is a no cost to us fundraiser, but players/families who get someone to work with Elite, would receive \$200 in the players account. Letter Writing is almost complete, 75% of what players earn goes to their account, 25% to the company Bear Cards will kick-off on July 29th, 100% of that money goes to the players accounts Fundraising money does not roll from year to year, cuts off each September
1.	Summer Workout/Calendar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Summer workouts will cost \$175.00 and all money is due on May 28th, after equipment handout. Board members will be at the school to collect the money and player information sheets. Payment needs to be in the form of cash, check or money order. We will look into credit card payments. Players who do not pay, will not be able to participate.
2.	Upcoming Season Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fees for the upcoming season will be \$600, this does not include the fee paid to Jeffco. Coach Morris advised that the \$600 will go towards helmets (~\$6k), new headsets, team meals (~\$3-4k), Hudl (~\$2k), Grand Junction trip (~\$4k) and the banquet (~\$4k) to name a few
3.	Online Store	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The team store will open again as we get closer to the season, but he will look into opening it again sooner than that.

4.	King Soopers Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The new program at King Soopers does not allow us to track the money by player, thus it will no longer go to individual accounts, but will go to the team. The previous six months will still apply, but after March 1st (when the new program started), it will go to the team.
5.	Volunteering Opportunities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As the season gets closer, we will be looking for more help for things such as the Homecoming parade, pancake breakfast, team meal, helmet decals, etc. If parents want to volunteer or have any ideas we should look into, bring them to the Board.
