Tournament Rules:

USBC CERTIFIED

- Entrants must be 50 years of age or older at the time of participation.
- Eligibility: All members of the FM USBC Association are eligible to enter. All members must have a prior year average or current year average with at least 12 games in the Association prior to the start of the tournament (October 3, 2026) to be eligible to participate. Membership is not available for purchase at tournament site.
- Multiple participation is allowed. Entrants can cash only once in the tournament with the highest cash value being awarded.
- A maximum of 6 people per pair is suggested at the discretion of the tournament manager.
- Four (4) games will be bowled. Winner of the tournament will be determined by total score of the four (4) games, plus handicap. Handicap is based on 90% of 220, no limit.
- Entering Average: USBC certified averages only will be accepted. The entering average will be the bowlers highest of:
 - The bowlers' highest previous final season average, minimum of 21 games.
 - Their present average if it is ten or more pins over their previous season's average, minimum of 12 games. A bowler not having an acceptable average under any of the above conditions must bowl scratch. BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THEIR OWN AVERAGE.
 - Rule 319 in its entirety is in effect for this tournament. If you have any questions regarding the application of this rule check with the Tournament Manager prior to bowling to avoid possible DISQUALIFICATION.
- All prizes will be paid on 1:4 basis. Champions in each division (open & women's) will be awarded a jacket or \$75 cash.
- Tournament manager reserves the right to disqualify any entrant whose conduct during the tournament is deemed to be detrimental to the game of bowling.
- All bowlers must comply with the USBC bowling ball specification rule (Chapter 8 shall apply).
- The winners of this tournament will be the FM USBC association city qualifiers to the State Seniors Tournament for the 2026-2027 season (the entry fees will be paid by the FM USBC). In case of a tie, the high scratch 4 game score will be declared the qualifier. If still tied, the bowler with the high single game scratch will be the qualifier.
- Entries close at the beginning of the final shift of the tournament. **Pre-registraion is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.**
- FM USBC Board of Directors will decide any questions not covered by these rules.
