2025 Youth Open Championship

1. **PARTICIPATION:** All participants must be a FM USBC Youth Member. Certification cannot be purchased at the event.
2. **AVERAGES:** Highest average as of November 28, 2025. Tournament Manager's discretion for less than 12 games minimum. FM USBC Association certified averages only. No averages or leagues related to traveling teams or high school teams qualify - use of invalid averages will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fee.
3. **RESERVATIONS:** *Please make reservations early!* Entries close at the beginning of the final shift of the tournament. *Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.*
4. **GENERAL AWARDS:** Awards will be based on 1:4 entries in the team event, doubles event, and singles event.
5. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions are permitted but must take the place of the original entrant's position in the line-up.
6. **HANDICAP:** Shall be based on 90% of 220, no limit. Individual handicap per event. Handicap shall be based on averages instead of ages in all divisions.
7. **DIVISIONS:** Shall be as follows:

Team Event: 4-member team - may be all boys, all girls or mixed

Doubles Event: May be both boys, both girls or a boy/girl

Singles Event: Will be separate boys and girl's divisions

All Events: The total of your first team score, doubles and singles scores

8. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** Events will be Team, Doubles & Singles. Doubles and singles in the same shift must be bowled in sequence. You must enter both events or neither. A bowler bowling doubles multiple times must change partners for each appearance. If a bowler places more than once in singles, they are only awarded once (the higher finish). A bowler may participate in Team multiple times with the change of at least 2 Team members each time. First appearance in any event counts towards all events.
9. **ENTRY FEE:** The entry fee is \$30.00 per bowler per event. That means it costs \$30.00 per bowler to bowl team event, \$30.00 per bowler to bowl doubles and \$30.00 per bowler to bowl singles for a total fee of \$90.00.
10. **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:** All prizes will be awarded as scholarships. The FM USBC Association will award a \$50 scholarship to the boy and girl Scratch All-Event Winner and boy and girl Handicap All-Event Winner. This will be paid through SMART account #09875. Total Scholarship awarded = \$200.
11. **DRESS CODE:** All bowlers shall be neat, clean and dressed in an appropriate manner. All bowlers shall be dressed modestly and should not reveal one's undergarments. Clothing with inappropriate language or gestures shall not be worn. No caps or headgear shall be worn. Any matters not covered shall be handled by the tournament manager. It is the responsibility of both the parents/guardians and the youth bowler to see that this dress code is followed.
12. **ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** All electronic devices and cell phones MUST BE TURNED OFF during tournament play. Disqualification may be at the discretion of the tournament manager.
13. **ALCOHOL:** There is no alcohol allowed during the youth bowling tournament shifts.
14. The FM USBC Board of Directors shall decide any questions not covered by the tournament rules.
