## Tournament Rules:

1.This is a 5-person team event open to each FM USBC League Champion team from their league for the 2023-2024 season. If the League Champion team can not bowl the tournament, the 2nd Place team becomes eligible. Non-USBC certified bowlers are not eligible to bowl in this event.
2.There will be one division in the tournament. Women's, Men's, and Mixed leagues are all eligible to participate.
3. The event is a 5 -member team tournament bowling three games each. Total pins, including handicap, will decide the winner.
4. Averages for the tournament will be the highest FINAL league average from the 2023-24 season, with a minimum of 21 games. Handicap will be $90 \%$ of 220.
5. USBC Rule 319 (b.c.d.e) will not be enforced.
6. At least two of the entering team's bowlers must be on their roster with a minimum of 21 games.
7.Teams from leagues with a playing strength of less than 5 bowlers may add bowlers from other teams in their league. The added bowlers must have a minimum of 21 games in their league and their average must be equal to or less than the composite average of the rostered bowlers bowling the tournament. If a non-rostered bowlers averages is higher than the composite of the rostered bowlers, the bowler must bowl scratch.
8. Entry fee will be $\$ 40.00$ per bowler with it split as follows: Lineage=\$12.00, Expenses=\$3.00, Prize Fund=\$25.00.
9. The prize fund will be paid out on a 1 for 3 ratio. Champions will receive a jacket or $\$ 75$.
10. Use of an average lower than the average required in Rule 4 will be grounds for disqualification. If the bowler uses an average higher than Rule 4 and the error is not corrected by the end of the first game, the bowler will use the higher average for the tournament. 11. USBC Rule 322a: A player or team missing one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall: begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled and will receive zeros for any frames missed.
12. Entries close at the start of the last shift of the tournament. Pre-registration is required or a walk-in fee of $\$ 5.00$ will be charged per person. Walk-ins are accepted based on lane availability.
13. USBC rules pertaining to equipment will be enforced.
14. The FM USBC Board of Directors shall decide any questions not covered by the tournament rules.
15. Smoking is NOT allowed during the tournament.
