

2026 CHIP AND SEAL PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The City of Wagner, South Dakota is seeking bids to chip and seal approximately 46,000 square yards, of hard surface streets. Submittal of a Bid Form and Contract shall be considered an offer and when accepted and countersigned by the Mayor shall become a binding contract to furnish the proposed and awarded items(s) as listed in this document. All bids must be received by March 16, 2026 at 4:00 pm and shall be submitted on the respective Bid Forms. TIME PERIOD

The project shall begin no earlier than July 1st, 2026 and be completed prior to August 15th, 2026.

WEATHER REQUIREMENTS

The application of surface treatment will be permitted only during daylight hours in dry conditions when the air and surface temperatures are at least 70 degree F.

SURFACE PREPARATION

The surface to be treated shall be thoroughly swept with a rotary power broom and cleaned of all loose and adhering foreign material by the seal coat contractor prior to the application of surface treatments.

MATERIALS

Asphalt, as shown on the bid form, (MC-3000) and aggregate (3/8" chips) are required to be used for the entire project. **The City of Wagner will purchase and provide the 3/8" chips to the seal contractor.** The seal coat contractor shall provide a weight ticket(s) for all asphalt used in the treatment application.

AGGREGATE COVER

Cover aggregate (3/8" chips), shall be spread immediately following application of the asphalt. The contractor shall protect the treated surface from any damage by traffic before the aggregate is applied.

Rolling shall begin immediately behind the aggregate spreader and shall consist of a minimum of four (4) complete coverage's using steel faced or pneumatic-tired rollers. **Must have two rollers.**

The contractor shall be responsible for the barricading of all streets involved during the progress of the work and shall be responsible for any damages done to the work due to a failure to provide adequate traffic control. City staff shall provide manhole and curb box covers and shall assist the seal coat contractor with the use of the covers.

The remaining loose material left on the surface will be removed by the City of Wagner and shall be the property of the City of Wagner.

QUANTITIES

The City of Wagner shall have the right to alter the quantities of the bid for either increasing or decreasing said items substantially to assure itself of completion of the project within the allowable funds.

BIDS

The Bid Form and Contract must include applicable sales taxes on materials and all other State of South Dakota and Federal taxes that would affect the amount of the bid and include the furnishings of all labor, materials, and equipment to perform all of the work as set forth in the specifications. Bids shall not be conditioned. The bidder shall agree to hold the bid firm for 30 days.

BOND

A bid bond, as per state statutes, shall be submitted with the sealed bid. A performance bond, for the faithful performance and maintenance of the contract, equal to the project's cost, shall be submitted 10 days after receipt of Notice of Award.
