Ruhollah Khomeini

Leader of the 1979 Iranian Revolution, influential in shaping Iran's current political and social landscape.

Mahmoud Ahmadinejad

Former President of Iran known for his controversial statements and policies.

Hassan Rouhani

Former President of Iran, known for his efforts to negotiate the Iran nuclear deal.

Ebrahim Raisi

Current President of Iran with a focus on conservative policies.

Zarif Mohammad Javad

Former Foreign Minister of Iran, a key figure in the Iran nuclear negotiations.

Javad Zarif

Former Iranian Foreign Minister and key negotiator of the nuclear deal.

Mohammad Javad Zarif

Prominent diplomat involved in U.S.-Iran relations.

Donald Trump

Former U.S. President who withdrew from the Iran nuclear deal.

Joe Biden

Former U.S. President involved in re-negotiations and diplomacy with Iran.

King Salman

Saudi Arabian monarch, influential in Middle Eastern politics and U.S.-Iran relations.

Mohammad bin Salman (MBS)

Crown Prince of Saudi Arabia with a significant influence on regional politics.

Gissou Nia

Human rights lawyer and activist focusing on women's rights in Iran.

Nikki Haley

Former U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations, known for her critical stance on Iran.

Abdullah II

King of Jordan, engaged in Middle Eastern diplomacy and regional stability.

Barack Obama

Former U.S. President who played a key role in the nuclear deal with Iran.

Mariam Askar

Iranian-American philanthropist and founder of the "Iranian American Women's Foundation," which supports women's rights and empowerment in Iran.

Dariush Borbor

Iranian-American businessman and philanthropist involved in supporting women's rights organizations in Iran.

Eliot Engel

Former U.S. Congressman and Chair of the House Foreign Affairs Committee, known for his critical stance on Iran's policies and human rights record.

Stephen Bannon

Former White House Chief Strategist under Donald Trump, influential in shaping the administration's hardline approach towards Iran.

Ali Khamenei

Supreme Leader of Iran, holding significant power over all branches of government and key decisions in Iran's domestic and foreign policy.

Qassem Soleimani

Former commander of the Quds Force, influential in Iran's military operations and regional influence, notably in Syria and Iraq.

Mohsen Fakhrizadeh

Iranian scientist considered a key figure in Iran's nuclear program, whose assassination in 2020 was a significant event in U.S.-Iran relations.

Emmanuel Macron

President of France, involved in European diplomacy and efforts to mediate tensions between Iran and the U.S., particularly regarding the nuclear deal.

Boris Johnson

Former Prime Minister of the United Kingdom who engaged in diplomatic efforts related to the Iran nuclear deal and U.S.-Iran relations.

Saeed Jalili

Former Secretary of Iran's Supreme National Security Council and nuclear negotiator for Iran. Currently serves on the Expediency Discernment Council.

Ali Larijani

Former Speaker of Iranian Parliament and military officer. Currently serves on the Expediency Discernment Council.

Mohsen Rezaei

Former military officer and conservative politician who currently serves as secretary of the Supreme Council for Economic Coordination and secretary of the Iranian government's Economic Committee.

Sadegh Larijani

Conservative politician who formerly served as Head of Iran's judiciary and currently chairs the Expediency Discernment Council.

Gholamali Khoshroo

Former Iranian Ambassador to the United Nations.

Faezeh Hashemi Rafsanjani

Former member of Parliament and Women's Rights Activist. Currently president of Executives of Construction Party, a reformist political party in Iran.

Ahmad Jannati

Parliament member as a conservative politician. Chairman of the Guardian Council in charge of checking Maji legislation and approving candidates of upcoming elections.

Mohammad Ali Jafari

Former Commander of the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps. Accused of facilitating suppression of protesters in Iran and Syria.

Mostafa Mohammad-Najjar

Former Minister of Defense and fierce advocate for the development of Iran's nuclear program. Suppressed any anti-government protests throughout his term.

Ali Akbar Salehi

Former Head of Atomic Energy Organization of Iran and foreign affairs minister. Supported advancement of Iran's nuclear program.

Mohammad Bagher Ghalibaf

Speaker of the Iranian Parliament and former military officer. Conservative politician involved in numerous corruption scandals.
