Captain Jack Sparrow

Hector Barbossa

Being the rival and nemesis of Jack, Hector Barbossa becomes the captain of the Black Pearl. He later becomes one of the key leaders among the pirates.

Davy Jones

Davy Jones was the ruler of the Seven Seas and the captain of the Flying Dutchman. He was cursed to ferry the souls of the dead, having been driven by his love for Calypso.

James Norrington

James Norrington is a naval officer and Elizabeth Swann's former fiancé. He plays a significant role in the ongoing struggle between the pirates and the British Empire.

Tia Dalma (Calypso)

Tia Dalma was a soothsayer of the Caribbean, later being revealed to be the sea goddess Calypso in human form. She has deep connections to the sea and the pirate lore.

Lord Cutler Beckett

Lord Cutler Beckett is the chairman of the East India Trading Company. He seeks to completely eliminate piracy, using many extreme sources to do so.

“Bootstrap” Bill Turner

Bill Turner is Will Turner's father, also being a crew member of the Flying Dutchman. Having his fate tied to the curse of Davy Jones, much conflict arises.

Governor Weatherby Swann

Governor Weatherby Swann is the father of Elizabeth Swann and the Governor of Port Royal. Though he made sure to proudly and efficiently rule over the British colony, Port Royal turned quite the opposite from a civilized world after the Black Pearl launched an attack.

Pintel

Pintel was a former crewman of the Black Pearl under Hector Barbosa.

Ragetti

Ragetti, being Pintel's partner in crime, was also a member of the pirate crew aboard the Black Pearl under Hector Barbosa.

Joshamee Gibbs

Joshamee Gibbs is a friend and former crewman of Jack Sparrow. He provides guidance and support throughout many of the conflicts.

Marty

Marty is a dwarf pirate and loyal member of Jack Sparrow's crew. His contribution to much of the conflicts consist of enthusiasm and support.

Cotton

Cotton is a mute pirate, communicating through his parrot. He is a devoted member of the Black Pearl, also being part of Jack Sparrow's inner circle.

Captain Teague

Captain Teague is Jack Sparrow's father and the Keeper of the Pirate Code. His wisdom and guidance to the pirates allows them to face the most difficult challenges.

Scarlett

Scarlett, being a woman from Tortuga, shares a long and complicated history with Jack Sparrow. Although her role is faint, she represents the chaotic and unpredictable nature of pirate life.

Giselle

Giselle was a woman living in a house in Tortuga during the Age of Piracy, along with Scarlett.

Captain Sao Feng

Captain Sao Feng is a Chinese pirate lord and one of the nine Pirate Lords of the Brethren Court. Throughout many events, he finds himself aligned sometimes with and/or against Jack Sparrow.

Murtogg

Murtogg is a British soldier and was stationed at Port Royal in the Caribbean, being under the command of Commodore James Norrington.

Mullroy

Mullroy, along with Murtogg, was a marine in the British Royal Navy, also being under Commodore James Norrington's command.

Lieutenant Gillette

Lieutenant Gillette is a loyal officer under James Norrington. He is disciplined and has a determined nature and attitude towards the British Navy.

Anamaria

Anamaria is a pirate who operated in the Caribbean, briefly joining Jack Sparrow's crew while also demanding restitution because of her stolen ship.

Mercer

Grapple

The Black Pearl's ship's carpenter and assists Jack Sparrow and the crew with ship repairs, also is a blacksmith and the owner of a smithy in the town of Port Royal.

Jimmy Legs

The bo'sun aboard the Flying Dutchman, under the command of Captain Davy Jones.

Wyvern

Crew member serving aboard the Flying Dutchman under Captain Davy Jones.

Mallot

One of Hector Barbossa's crewmen, also worked with the cursed crew of the Black Pearl.

Maccus

Sailor who served as First Mate aboard the cursed Flying Dutchman.

Palifico

Crew member on Flying Dutchman.

Captain Bellamy

Pirate captain and member of the Brethren Court.

Tai Huang

Pirate lord of Singapore from the Brethren Court, Chinese pirate who served as the second in command to Sao Feng.

Ho-Kwan

Pirate operating in the 1720s, recruited by Captain Jack Sparrow as a part of his crew.
