PalmCon: The Palm Beach County Comic Book and Collectibles Show returns for the first time since 2016, just in time for their 10th anniversary. This comic convention will take over the entire American Polish club including the lounge, the Crystal Ballroom and the 4800 square foot Grand Ballroom.

There has been an amazing amount of support from the local comic scene for the return of PalmCon. All of the tables have been booked, and the hall will be filled with many guests including artists, publishers, filmmakers and more. There will be over 50 vendor, artist, and guest tables offering a wide variety of merchandise, crafts, original artwork, collectibles, publications, and more. There will be two raffles, a costume contest, informative panels and discussions, simulated sword combat demonstrations, a fun Mad-Libs Draw Off, and many other activities throughout the day.

This event originally grew out of show promoter Martin T. Pierro's love for the small hotel and mall comic shows that were a staple of his youth. After taking a short time off from hosting PalmCon to focus on his other business - Cosmic Times ( a comic book publishing house) he felt that the 10th anniversary was a perfect opportunity to bring PalmCon back.

Continuing to be a community centric show, PalmCon has partnered with the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and the Palm Beach County Library System to help promote the arts and literacy on a local level. Also PalmCon is involved with several local schools to help them with their fundraising efforts in these challenging times. Part of PalmCon's commitment to the community is reflected in their admission pricing, setting out to ensure that a family of four could get a full day of comic con style entertainment for \$20 or less.
