Communications Committee: Engage membership and the community through media outreach. Brand and market CBTU so that our message appeals to workers of all ages and community.

CARAT Programs Committee (Community Action and Response against Toxics): Recognizing the compelling need for ethnic minorities to have access to information about toxic chemicals and the strategic role that trade unionists can play in the process, the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists initiated the CARAT Team. CARAT Teams are a network of local environmental justice alliances whose mission is to empower workers and residents to work together to promote environmental quality in African American and other minority communities.

Education Committee: Education and engagement that will enable members to articulate CBTU's mission and goals and develop self-interest rationale for membership in CBTU. Provide professional and personal development opportunities to members.

Financial Resources Committee: Increase the financial stability of CBTU and ensure longevity through on-going funding activities.

Men's Committee Programs Committee: The committee is based on a simple principle, through sustained mentoring programs, implementing and promoting mentoring as a critical transformative vehicle in the lives of youth health. We use our network to deliver programs in our unions, communities and at the annual Regional conference.

Membership and Organizing Committee: Broaden the power and influence of CBTU by increasing community outreach initiatives, engaging membership in education and promoting chapter expansion.

Political Action and GOTV Committee: Expand member awareness, knowledge, and ability to participate in political engagement activities. Increase the number of CBTU members who are actively involved in the chapter and local political campaigns.

Women's Committee: Engages in outreach programs that bring awareness to education issues, domestic violence, politics and leadership development and health issues facing women of color. We have an annual conference with workshops that focus on the needs of women in the trade union movement.

Young Workers (Under 40) Committee: Increase young worker engagement and participation by 25-30% through mentoring, scholarship and partnerships in our local chapter, regional conference and international convention.
