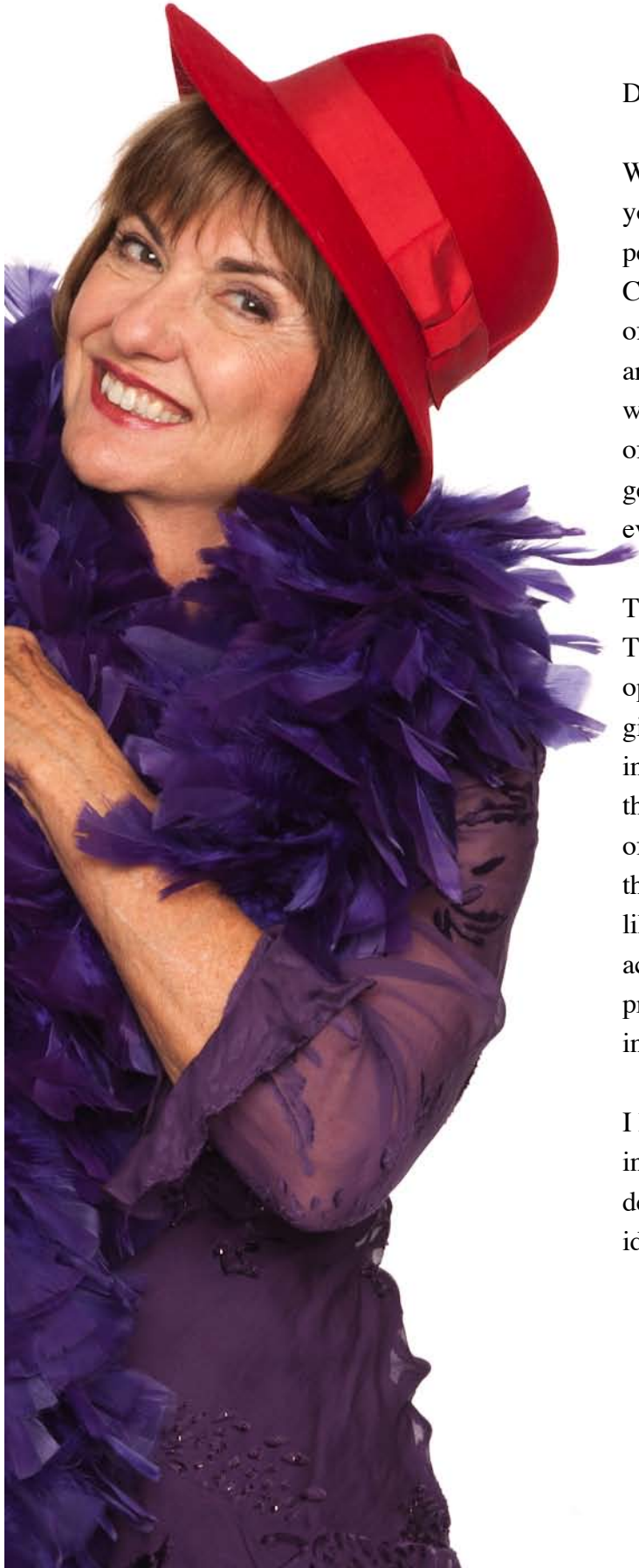

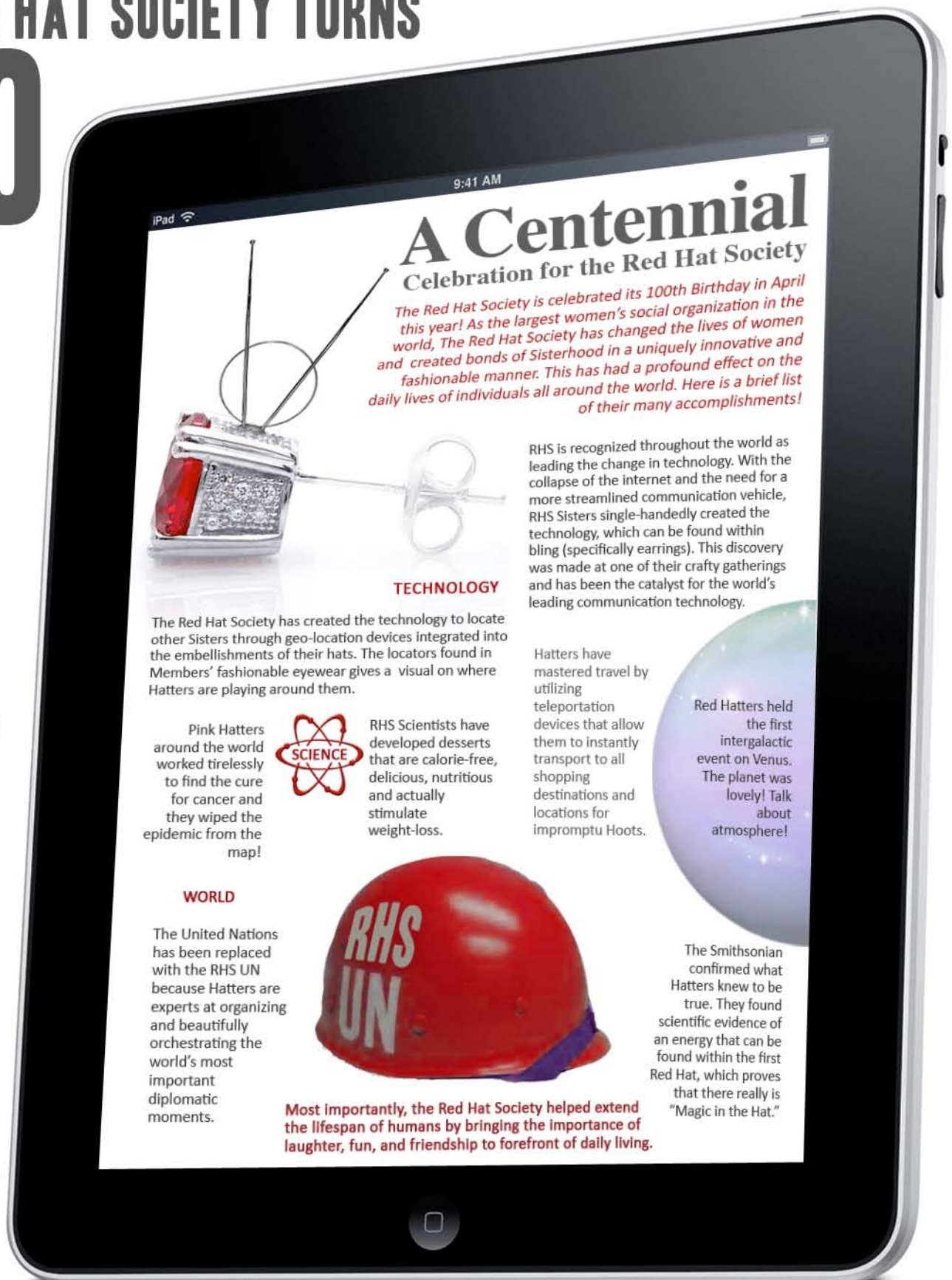

Becky's Chapter, The Red Hat Power Ladies, have since hosted their fourth gathering, and they have eight Supporting Members! Becky carries brochures everywhere she goes, which include the "Warning" poem printed in both English and German and proudly states that The Red Hat Power Ladies are the only Official German Chapter, to promote The Red Hat Society and her Chapter.

Becky has created quite a Chapter in her city in such a short amount of time by making it accessible and fun for her Chapterettes! They have been to two posh establishments for tea, and they are planning a trip to France. According to Becky, because Germans do not like to wear uniforms, nor do they like to appear "ridiculous" in public, it really is a giant leap for women to step out in RHS regalia. As part of their acceptance to the Red Hat Power Ladies, the women must attend an event in public in full regalia to ensure that they are ready to take on the attention that it will bring their way. Although this was meant to be a special activity for the runners, it ended up being rewarding for the Hatters who participated as well, because several runners stopped to take pictures of and dance with them. Some runners approached Members after the race to thank them for their participation, and in the days following the race, Hatquarters was still receiving emails from runners who appreciated their presence at the race. Here are a few of the wonderful comments we received:
