The American Rescue Plan American
Rescue Plan
Act of 2021
Act (ARPA) was signed into law by President Biden on

March 11, 2021. The **Township received** roughly \$136,000 to assist in our COVID-19 response; and has until 2026 to use the funds or give back to the government.

In 2021, the Township used \$10,000 for the initial deposit to the audio and video conferencing system.

Throughout 2022, \$63,000 was utilized for the remaining balance on the audio and video conferencing system, security system install, new entry door to the Shop, handicap accessible entry door to the Hall, flag pole, and the engineering fees for the Quarry Ave road project with the Watertown-Mayer School District.

The Township has \$63,000 in remaining funds.

Note that no resident levy money is being used for these projects.

New Tractor: 2022 JD 5075E



The Township purchased a new tractor, a 2022 John Deere 5075E with 75 hp. The John Deere tractor

replaced a 2003 CaselH JX75 with 2,500 hours. The price of the new tractor was \$27,739 after trade-in.

Right of Way Reminder

It is unlawful to perform unauthorized work (tilling, planting) within a road right-of-way, as well as, to deposit snow, or other debris on or next to a public highway or street per MN Statute 160.2715 and Watertown Township Ordinance.

Mumford Sanitation Recycling Service

The Township provides a free recycling service to residents through Mumford Sanitation. The 5 year contract started in March 2018 and will be renewed in March 2023. The Township receives a county grant to cover a portion of the cost. If you'd like to participate and receive a 65 gallon cart, contact Wayne Hubin or Barry Fritzke at 952.955.2446.

Completed in 2022: Paved Quarry Ave (by school); replaced culvert aprons and extensions; repaired Swede Lake Rd frost boil; filled Oxford and County Rd 24 transitions to match up with County Road Project; hauled 1,200 tons of granite (32nd)

St, Common St, Township Shop pile) and 2,700 yards of class 5 gravel (various roads)

Proposed for 2023: Granite east end of Swede Lake Rd; tile Swede Lake Rd; tile 62nd St; replace Rose Ave bridge

Resident Mailbox Support

The mailbox support is the personal property of the homeowner and allowed in the road right-of-way. To help reduce your liability, install a swing-away mailbox support. All solar garden proposals must be submitted to the Township Board and Township Planning Committee for review and determination of its applicability.
