Cadets are required to re-take Weapon Handling Tests regularly to ensure that they remain trained, current and competent in line with the Cadet Safe System of Training. Marksmanship All Cadet Forces Adult Volunteers planning and delivering Initial Weapon Training and Live Firing Marksmanship Training are **Training** trained, current, competent and qualified to do so under the Cadet Safe System of Training and are subject to regular assessment and compliance activities. The MOD does all it can to reduce the risk of Live Firing Marksmanship Training to be as low as reasonably practicable and the RAF Air Cadets will carefully supervise your child and ensure their safety at all times.
