


Even with the best movers, accidents can sometimes occur. Talk to your mover about valuation, and be aware of the distinction between released value at 60 cents per pound and complete value protection.

For relocation coverage, check your homeowners or rental insurance plans.



HIGH RISE ROOF REPAIR
