8. Crocheted article not previously mentioned
9. Special - 2019 Red Scarf Project - Crocheted Red Scarf - any type of yarn is accepted but the colour can only be red. Any shade of red yarn is accepted but only red, no other colours added. Any style of scarf, including infinity scarves, accepted but must be considered a scarf and can be any length. No other accessories accepted. 6. Article of counted cross stitch
7. Sewn Pillowcase
8. Stuffed toy under 24"
9. Sewed tote bag
10. Sewed article from fleece
11. Sewn apron
12. Article of sewing for an adult
13. Article of sewing for a child
14. Sewn receiving blanket
15. Mittens made from recycled sweaters

1. A wrapped gift - 8" or under
2. Handmade Seasonal wreath with hanger
3. Any handmade holiday center piece
4. Christmas stocking ... handmade
5. Christmas ornaments – group of 3, handmade, mounted
6. Advent Calendar ... handmade
7. Handmade Wall decoration any event
8. Handmade Christmas tree skirt
9. Handmade Halloween decoration
10. Hand decorated Wineglass, any occasion

Quilts (Hand quilted) – Class 57

All quilts in sections 1-2 MUST BE a minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter to go on to the District to be judged. All quilts in this class must be hand quilted by the exhibitor.

1. Quilt – pieced, minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter - pattern named
2. Quilt – appliquéd, minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter - pattern named
3. Quilt – pieced, must be under 324" measured on the perimeter
4. Quilt – quilting only to be judged, must be under 324" measured on the perimeter
5. Quilt – tied, any size
6. Quilt top only, any size
7. Group quilt, pieced or appliqued, any size
8. Quilt – suitable for a boy or girl's room, any size
9. Crib quilt, pre-printed fabric – No hand tied quilts
10. Hand quilted item

Quilts (machine quilted) – Class 58

All quilts in sections 1 and 2 MUST BE a minimum of 324" measured on the perimeter. Note the quilt can be square, rectangular etc. Sections 1 and 2 qualify to go on to the next level of competition. All quilts in this class must be machine quilted by the exhibitor.

1. Quilt pieced, total perimeter measurement to be min. 324" - pattern named
2. Quilt appliquéd, total perimeter measurement to be min. 324" - pattern named
3. Quilt – pieced or appliqued, must be under 324" measured on the perimeter
4. Quilt suitable for boy or girl
5. Crib quilt, pieced or appliquéd
6. Wall hanging, no larger than 40" x 40"
7. Lap quilt, not over 45" x 60"
8. Quilt made from scraps, machine quilted, approx 48" x 60"
9. Memory quilt, any size
10. Paper pieced quilt, any size
11. Rag quilt, any size
12. Miniature quilt - pieced or appliqued - maximum size 80" measured on the perimeter

Quilts – Class 59

More and more quilts are being sent out to be quilted. Commercial quilting will be allowed in this class. The exhibitor must have created the top and binding but the actual quilting can be done commercially. Must provide name of quilter.

1. Quilt, hand quilted - appliqued or pieced – total perimeter measurement to be min. 324"
2. Quilt, hand quilted appliqued or pieced – must be under 324" measured on the perimeter
3. Quilt - hand quilted - suitable for boys or girls room, any size
4. Quilt, machine quilted appliqued or pieced - total perimeter measurement to be min. 324"
5. Quilt, machine quilted appliqued or pieced – must be under 324" measured on the perimeter
6. Quilt, machine quilted - suitable or boys or girls room, any size
