This phone is answered 24 hours/day by an R.N. Patients needing more in depth care are referred to a network of volunteering specialists and primary care physicians.

- Treats 20-25 patients. If two physicians are working, 30-35 patients are seen
- No gynecological exams
- No lab work
- Flu shots given on specific dates (generally 1-2 days in the fall)
- Clinic pharmacy does not dispense any controlled or injectable medications
- Prayer needs

Patients wanting medications refilled must first see the clinic physician and have the number of refills allowed noted. Refills are filled according to availability.
