WHY TRYING TO PLEASE EVERYONE IS A TRAP

1. IT CAUSES ME TO MISS GOD'S
Our purpose is to please God, not people. He is the one who examines the motives of our hearts. 1 Thes. 2:4b (NLT)
2. IT KEEPS MY FAITH
You try to get praise from each other, but you do not try to
get the praise that comes from the only God. So how car you believe? John 5:44 (NCV)
3. IT LEADS
Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong! Exo. 23:2a
Saul confessed to Samuel, " <u>I've sinned</u> . I've trampled roughshod over God's Word and your instructions. I <u>cared</u> more about pleasing people so I let them tell me what to do.' 1 Sam. 15:24 (Mes)
4. IT EXPOSES
Jesus: "You make yourselves look good in other people's
eyes but God knows your hearts." Luke 16:15a (TEV)
You may brag about yourself, but the only approval that counts is the Lord's approval. 2 Cor. 10:18 (CEV)
<u>counts</u> is the Lord's approval.
5. IT SILENCES
No one had the courage to speak favorably about Jesus in public, for they were <u>afraid of getting in trouble</u> with the leaders.
