Fees & Insurance: Total booth cost for two days is \$50.00 for a 12x12 spot, 2 spots for \$75.00. The fee should be submitted along with page 3 of this application and a copy of your insurance certificates: one naming Oakfield Betterment Committee, 5 North Pearl St Oakfield NY 14125 additional insured, and one naming Village of Oakfield, 37 Main St Oakfield NY 14125 as additional insured .If you don't have insurance, you can get a 3-day insurance for \$49.00 from ACT Insurance www.actinsurance.com

Vendor Information and Rules

All craft vendors are required to submit an application.

If you are interested, please complete and mail your application, along with application fee and descriptions and/or photos of items you intend to sell to: Oakfield Betterment Committee, Attn: Craft Chair, P.O. Box 2, Oakfield, NY 14125. All applications need to be received ASAP.

- 1. All vendors need to supply their own tents, tables and displays (Spaces are 12' x 12')
- 2. The vendor is not required to be at the event both days (Sunday and Monday). However, the fee will be the same. Please note that due to Parade preparations, it will be difficult to gain access to vendor area to set up Monday morning. We strongly recommend participating both days.
- 3. No Vehicles or Trailers will be allowed behind, next to or near your booth space. A parking area away from the booth area will be designated for crafters to park their vehicles and trailers. For set-up you will be able to access your area with a vehicle and once you have unloaded your vehicle/trailer it will need to be removed. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this requirement.
- 4. The vendor registration fee is non-refundable.
- 5. There are no rain-dates for the festival.
- 6. Electricity will be NOT be available to the craft booths. Generators are prohibited.
- 7. Each Booth is to be kept tidy with clean-up the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- 8. Booth Assignments: Booth will be assigned with date & time to set-up
- 9. There will be no changing of booth assignments on the days of the festival.
- 10. Space assignments will be random and are not to be requested.
- 11. Setup must be complete, and roadways clear prior to the start time of 10:00 am. The hours for the craft show will be from 10am 6pm each day. Private security will be present overnights.
